First Mini Tournament Results

First mini-tournament of the year, scheduled for June 25, actually happened this year. Last year. this event was cancelled due to bad weather, so it was good to have the event happen as planned. There were seven boats entered at \$10 each. PSA added in matching funds to the winners. Five boats weighed in fish that totaled 117.15 lbs. for 21 fish. First place, Big Fish, was won by the Producer Fishing Team with an 18.4# King Salmon. Second place, Most Fish, was won by Breakaway, with 6 fish. Third place was Mystery Weight, a weight randomly chosen by someone who did not fish, 4.1#. The boat Lyme Time won 3rd place money by coming closest with 3.6#. The payout for each was 1st, \$65, 2nd, \$39 and 3rd \$26. A good time was had by all.
