## HOW TO RE-INSERT FABRIC IN CASE

- 1. Unroll the awning and lock the Z-Lock (if your awning dose not have a Z-Lock, someone will have to hold the roller from turning).
- 2. Have someone push and hold the roller toward the vehicle to relieve Tension on the fabric.
- 3. Remove the screw from the bead of the fabric (**Figure 1**).
- 4. Using vice-grips or pliers, open crimped spots in the channel of the slat to their original width (in the area that the fabric will be re-inserted). See (Figure 1).
- 5. Open the channel just enough to insert the bead of the fabric for 1 1/2" directly adjacent to where the fabric stopped pulling out of the slat. See (Figure 2).
- 6. Insert the fabric into the channel and pull till the fabric is even with the end of the slat. Press the fabric bead into the channel at the 1 1/2" opening.
- 7. Use a vise grip pliers to close down the remaining crimps that were previously opened (**Figure 3**) just enough to prevent the fabric from shifting in the case channel.
- 8. Replace screw in cord.






