Our latest Hands On project is in the Magdalena Medio region in Colombia, South America. For over 50 years, Colombia has suffered so much. More than 280,000 people have been killed in the conflict; many of these children. Working with our local partner Programa de Desarrollo y Paz (Peace and Development Programme), people living in the Magdalena Medio region plan to educate and empower young people to resolve conflict peacefully.
