

ORDINANCE NUMBER 13

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MARION, CENTRE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REGULATING VEHICULAR TRAFFIC IN THE TOWNSHIP BY PROVIDING FOR MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS ESTABLISHED ON CERTAIN STREETS AS HEREINAFTER SET FORTH; IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT enacted and ordained by the Township of Marion it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority the same as follows:

1., Pursuant to the authority vested in the Township Supervisors of Marion Township the said Township requested the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation to conduct an engineering study of certain public roads in the Township of Marion for the purpose of establishing speed limits.

The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Transportation pursuant to Sections 3362 and 3363 of the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code and Section 20131 of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation Regulations has conducted said study and on September 12, 1988 made recommendations to the Township Supervisors of Marion Township to establish the hereinafter set forth speed limits on the designated Township roads.

2. In order to promote the safety of the citizens of the Township of Marion and persons using the public highways of Marion Township and by virtue of the authority vested in the Township Supervisors by the Second Class Township Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and also by the applicable provisions of the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code and pursuant to the recommendations of the district traffic engineer of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Transportation maximum speed limits are established on portions of specified streets in the Township of Marion, as hereinafter set forth, and it shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle, on a part of a street or road where a maximum speed limit applies, at a higher speed than the maximum perscribed for that part of the street:

3. The appropriate Township employees are directed to erect appropriate signs indicating the restricted speed limits as hereinbefore established, which signs are to be erected in accordance with Penn Dot regulations and the report of the traffic study by the Penn Dot.

4. Any person, firm or corporation who violates any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof in a summary proceeding be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) and not more than fifty dollars (\$50.00). Any person exceeding the maximum speed limit by more than five (5) miles per hour shall pay an additional fine of two dollars (\$2.00) per mile for each mile in excess of five (5) miles per hour over the maximum speed limit.

This ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after its enactment.
