- Internet Open Sources difference between surface and deep web, international searching, how to identify ownership and domain of websites, how to identify relationships/associations of targeted subjects
- Social Networking Sites identifying Facebook ID, track hashtags across platforms, geo locate Instagram photos and Twitter postings, locate personal online photo albums, how to properly view "private" Facebook information
