LEVEL UP DIRECTIONS

HEART DRAWING

Use the pen tool to create the heart on the page to the right.

Color the heart with a two color radial gradient. Neither color should be black OR white.

Add the highlight details, set their blending mode to OVERLAY and LOWER their OPACITY.

Remove the stroke from the heart.

Your heart should be extremely smooth. Try to correct any mistakes using the WHITE ARROW before using the WARP tool or **SMOOTH** tool.

Two color radial gradient

No stroke

White highlights drawn with pencil
Set to OVERLAY and OPACITY lowered.

Pen shape as smooth as possible.
Only 6 points used on my drawing.
Each curve has a beginning, middle, and end.
