

Fundraising Firearms Courses for WPPCCO

The following pistol and AR-5 style rifle courses/modules come from Paul Howe, former US Army Special Operations and owner of Combat Shooting and Tactics (CSAT). Rick Basagoitia, CSAT Instructor and owner of Firearms and Tactics Courses and Training (FaT CaT) will teach the following courses and donate a portion of the proceeds to WPPCCO. Rick is also a certified Colorado law enforcement officer/instructor with 22 years of experience in the field and teaching firearms skills to all sorts of students ranging from children to SWAT operators, both male and female. Live-fire Concealed Carry Tactical Pistol - \$325 (6 shooters). All other course prices are \$250/person with a maximum of 12 shooters.

One-day Tactical Pistol Course –

If any of the following statements apply to you, then this course is right for you:

- You're a novice and recently purchased a new semi-automatic handgun or was given one as a gift and want to know how to use it
- You're an experienced shooter who wants to perform at a professional operator level or want solid skills for competition
- You are a law enforcement officer wanting to hone your pistol skills beyond what academy and in-service training can typically provide
- You are former military and would like pistol training to a level not typically provided to conventional units

First-time and experienced shooters alike will learn and be challenged in this course. You'll learn all the primary skill sets and how to practice them in the future to have a solid foundation for pistol employment. Whether your intended end use is for self-defense, competition, law enforcement or military, this course offers the technical skills that you need. This course teaches nine skills drills that cover all the bases. You'll be given shooting work outs and a performance assessment tool to track your progress. Lastly, the performance standards will challenge and help you grow into a highly competent pistol handler.

One-day Concealed Carry Tactical Pistol – See the following notice.

*****Attention for those interested in Concealed Carry training and permits**

The vast majority of “concealed carry” courses are mostly classroom/lecture-type classes. Few offer live-fire courses to help you learn the skills that you will need if you ever have to draw and use your concealed firearm in real life. With the wide variety and quality of concealable holsters and disparate skill levels of those interested in these types of classes, muzzle and trigger finger discipline issues can be significant.

Colorado law allows the permit applicant to choose whichever pistol course they want to take with a competent instructor to earn a training certificate and it will qualify you for permitting purposes. Any of the pistol courses listed in this document will work for you to get a permit and all students who successfully complete the course will receive a certificate. You don't have to take a concealed carry specific course. If you want to learn how to use your pistol and be proficient with it, you'll do no better than taking any one of the courses listed here. If there is sufficient interest, I can offer a concealed carry specific tactical pistol course, but the cost will be higher and the number of students will be limited. I will also restrict the types of holsters and holster placement that I will allow on the range for this class. Also, many feel the need to lighten triggers or replace stock triggers with aftermarket triggers. These are not suitable for open enrollment live-fire concealed carry classes. Live-fire concealed carry is a one of the most dangerous courses in the training industry.

One-day Pistol Diagnostics and Skills Development –

We all experience challenges with pistol marksmanship and gun handling skills, but without professional instruction and coaching, you will lag at a certain level. If you're an experienced pistol shooter and want to hone your skills beyond your current level of proficiency, this course is for you. This course includes the following:

- live-fire evaluation
- video review and slow-motion diagnostics
- pistol skills correctional and developmental drills

One-day Tac Rifle –

This one-day course teaches the primary skill sets to professionally employ the M4/AR-15 style rifle along with the pistol. This is an excellent follow-up course to the Tactical Pistol Operator or for those with intermediate to advanced pistol skills already. The design is similar as the TPO course in that we provide:

- skills workouts
- performance evaluation tools
- proficiency standards to strive to motivate your training

The curriculum is designed to leave no one behind nor leave anyone unchallenged. It is typical for civilian novices to take this course alongside veteran police and military personnel.

One-day Precision Rifle Operator –

This course focuses on precision rifle handling and marksmanship including, but not limited to:

- precision rifle fundamentals
- understanding and using the tactical scope
- ballistic computers
- environmental effects on your bullet's trajectory

It is my job is to distill the complexities down to easily learned modules so that you have a simple system for field application.
