

Minutes of the Interlaken Village Board of Trustees meeting held on Thursday June 8, 2023 at the Village Hall and via Go-to-Meetings

Mayor Richardson called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm with the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Motion made by Del Plato to accept the May 25, 2023 minutes, second Garcia, carried.

Water: Flagg's refuses DPW to put recharge system in the lake. (Pump sits on their dock)

Rural water here, know there is a leak on West Ave or close to it. 10-15 thousand gal/day lost 20% of normal use. Using Ovid's camera next week to look in the line,

Sewer: Quiet. Richardson sent email to property owners regarding drying bed land purchase

Streets: Sawyer Updike hired as summer help, starts in two weeks.

Tree trimming on Main school crossing lights now visible. Removed concrete; tried to repair catch basin in front of Gun Black

Belt on mower fixes, getting 50 cones from Sen Co Highway for Olde Home Day event, IPD picking up other signage from Comet Flashing.

Richardson motioned, second Garcia to put the Mechanic/Knight St project out to bid, carried.

Richardson to put on Contract Reporter and write an ad for publication in Seneca Co Area Shopper.
