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

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It Takes a Village

120 C8 Corvettes Damaged by the Kentucky Tornado Will Be Demolished

Dozens of <u>Chevrolet C8 Corvettes</u> may have survived a tornado last month, but that doesn't mean they're out of danger.

In fact, about 120 examples of the iconic sports car are now scheduled to be demolished, <u>according to Jalopnik</u>. The vehicles, which were damaged when a catastrophic tornado hit Kentucky and five other states last month, will reportedly be scrapped to ensure no defective cars end up on the road.

The cars were damaged when a massive tornado struck the <u>General Motors</u>'s plant where the C8 <u>Corvette</u> is built in Bowling Green, Kentucky. Although the toll of the deadly tornado was worse in other areas, the factory suffered major damage, including its roof and employee entrance catching on fire. Fortunately, none of the workers at the plant were hurt, but production was temporarily halted so that the damage could be dealt with, a process that has continues into this year.

The damage also extended to a number of completed vehicles that were ready to be shipped, including the C8 Corvettes that are headed for the crusher. Although <u>footage of the banged-up cars</u> shows varying degrees of harm, you'd think at least some of them could be salvageable. While that may or may not be the case, they will be destroyed to ensure the safety of Chevy's customers. That means that some customers who were just about to get the mid-engine 'Vette have to wait even longer to get their hands on the vehicle.

"All customer vehicles coming off of the line after the downtime caused by December's storm meet the high level of quality our customers expect," a representative for Chevy told *Robb Report* on Thursday. "Vehicles and vehicle parts in the plant that were damaged by the storm are being scrapped and will not be used in production.

"If a customer's order was impacted by the storm, the customer will be contacted by their dealer and their order will be prioritized and re-sequenced back into production, with an expected production date as quickly as possible."

This is yet <u>another production issue</u> for the C8 Corvette, though. Initial production was <u>delayed by the UAW strike</u> in the fall of 2019, then Covid-19 brought the world to a stop in March 2020, causing more delays and <u>forcing GM to cut production</u> of the 2020 model drastically. This past year wasn't much better, with supply chain issues causing at least three separate stoppages.













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Through January 3rd, just about every GM model is eligible for a special Price Protection Program. Based on the fine print, the incentive can be applied toward vehicles built on or after the effective date of a price hike. To take advantage of it, buyers will need to have placed an order before new pricing goes into effect.



Fortunately, there's no word yet on a Corvette price increase. While manufacturer price hikes are common from year-to-year, shoppers may not know that mid-year price increases can happen at any time. <u>2022 Corvette pricing</u> starts at \$62,195, \$1,200 more than the sold-out <u>2021 model</u> because of a change in equipment.

With a great deal of uncertainty surrounding delivery dates and production schedules, the program could be particularly helpful for Corvette buyers looking to lock-in current MSRPs. Other brands have been paying buyers to wait, sometimes with interest rate-lock offers and cash incentives on factory-ordered cars.

Soon after the <u>2023 Corvette</u> was revealed, early <u>Z06 reservation details</u> began to emerge. One dealer even <u>asked people to stop calling</u> due to its enormous backlog of open 2022 Corvette orders. Next year, the Z06 promises to offer the most powerful naturally-aspirated production V8 with <u>an output of 670 horsepower</u>.

If you're in the market for a Corvette, <u>expect to pay a premium</u>. Base models remain <u>practically impossible to find</u> and there continue to be significant dealer markups. Sadly, shoppers may find that simply being able to find a dealer willing to sell the extremely sought-after car at MSRP could be a chore in itself.

A first-year <u>C3 Corvette</u> owned new by an astronaut with perhaps the oldest ties to Chevy's legendary sports car is being <u>offered at no reserve</u> at the Barrett-Jackson Auction set for Jan. 22-30 in Scottsdale, Arizona.

Alan Shepard was one of the first 12 astronauts in the NASA program and went on to become the first American in outer space and eventually was one of the few who ever walked on the moon.

Shepard's history with Corvettes goes all the way back to his first brush with the car, a used '53, and he was driving a used '57 while training in Florida for the Mercury space program.

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







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























IMSA Releases Mega Entry List for the Roar Before the Rolex 24, 13 GTD-Pro Entries

Corvette Racing bears watching as always, but in particular, as it shifts from the GTLM platform to the GT3 specification the GTD PRO falls under. The No. 3 Corvette won last year's Rolex 24 and the driver trio returns with Antonio Garcia, Jordan Taylor and Nicky Catsburg. The No. 4 Corvette won the 2021 qualifying race and is back on a one-off for the Rolex 24 before taking on a full season in the FIA World Endurance Championship.

We always like to pass along good news when it comes our way and today's news is especially good for those Corvette enthusiasts whose orders for their new 2022 Corvettes are getting ready for production.


On Tuesday, the <u>Corvette Assembly Plant</u> completed the building of 197 new Corvettes which we believe is the single-day record for C8 Corvette production. The production team followed up that great news by producing 195 Corvettes on Wednesday. During normal times (yeah, when was that again?) the plant is set up to complete 184 Corvettes total or 92 per shift.

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

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
