They're making ice at the Two Harbors Curling Club! The Curling season will begin on October 26th with a Community Open House, where all are welcome to come in and give curling a try. With instructors and equipment available for use, it's a free opportunity to try your hand at one of the fastest growing winter sports in the area. Recent popularity stems from the success of the USA Men's Curling team in the Winter Olympics, creating increased visibility of the sport.

The Two Harbors Curling Club is a non-profit organization run by its membership who volunteer to ensure the long-term viability of this recreational opportunity. The Club is also supported by local businesses who sponsor teams, advertise and provide donations. Recent facility upgrades and improvements were made possible by local business partners and grants available in our community.

This is sport for all ages! Open Houses, adult Learn to Curl classes, KidsCurl League (ages 6-12), Junior League (ages 12-18) and Novice League will be starting soon. Registration is through Community Ed. Club volunteers also teach curling to Silver Bay and Two Harbors High School Phy-Ed students.

In addition to weekly league play, the Club hosts four major weekend bonspiels attracting 32 teams to our community to compete. This year, the Two Harbors Curling Club was selected by the US Curling Association to host the week-long Junior National Playdowns, where the winning team will representing the United States at Junior Worlds. This event will be held January 12-19th.

Members of the Two Harbors Curling Club volunteer their time knowing this exposure to potential new curlers is the lifeblood of our Club. And who knows, we could help create future Olympic Curlers!
