Swim Meet Job Duty	Job Description
Announcer	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Announce National Anthem at the start of each home meet• Announce race, heat and swimmer information• Announce important information as needed throughout the meet
Starter	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Evaluate swimmers to ensure proper position on block• Give starting command• Signal for false start
Timers	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Check stop watch to ensure it is good working order• Pair up with timer from opposing team and select lane• Start and stop time at the beginning and end of each race• Compare time with opposing team stopwatch and average time• Record time and all other race/swimmer information on time sheet
Stroke Judge	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Must be familiar with the proper mechanics of all of the strokes, turns and relay exchanges• Must determine disqualification of any swimmer that does not meet the above stated criteria
Place Judge	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Stands at the finishing end of the pool and marks who finishes in a certain place
Scorers	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Obtain time sheets from runners• Tabulate swimmers' times and team scores
Runner	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Collects time sheets from each of the lane timers and delivers them to the scorers
Concession stand	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Assist concession manager with sales
50/50 raffle sales	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Sells 50/50 raffle tickets
