## “Mental Health Month”

May is national Mental Health Awareness Month. Below, I've listed stats for the U.S. and Iowa (All stats are from NAMI Iowa — National Alliance on Mental Illness) They are eye-opening. The church can be an example of loving our neighbors by being involved in work for better mental health care. We can also take time this month to check in with ourselves and others, and seeking help if needed.



- 1 in 5 U.S. adults experience mental illness each year.
- 473,000 adults in Iowa have a mental health condition. (That's more than 3x the population of Cedar Rapids)
- 1 in 20 U.S. adults experience serious mental illness each year. In Iowa, that's 128,000 adults.
- 1 in 6 U.S. youth aged 6-17 experience a mental health disorder each year. 37,000 Iowans aged 12-17 have depression.
- More than half of people with a mental health condition in the U.S. did not receive any treatment in the last year. Of the 154,000 adults in Iowa who did not receive needed mental health care, 29.3% did not because of cost. (4.7% of people in Iowa are uninsured)
- Iowans are over 2x more likely to be forced out-of-network for mental health care than for primary health care — making it more difficult to find care and less affordable due to higher out-of-pocket costs.
- 1,821, 289 people in Iowa live in a community that does not have enough mental health professionals.
- High school students with depression are more than 2x more likely to drop out than their peers. 58.1% of Iowans aged 12-17 who have depression did not receive any care in the last year.
- 2, 647 people in Iowa are homeless and 1 in 5 live with a serious mental illness.
- 1 in 4 people with a serious mental illness has been arrested by the police at some point in their lifetime — leading to over 2 million jail bookings of people with serious mental illness each year. About 2 in 5 adults in jail or prison have a history of mental illness. 7 in 10 youth in the juvenile justice system have a mental health condition.
- On average, 1 person in the U.S. dies by suicide every 11 minutes. In Iowa 490 lives were lost to suicide and 129,000 adults had thoughts of suicide in the last year.
