1. INVITATION: The National Rifle Association of Ireland invites F-Class shooters of all countries to compete in the 2017 Emerald Individual and Team Matches.
2. RANGE LOCATION: Midlands National Shooting Centre of Ireland, Blue Ball, Tullamore, Co. Offaly.
3. RULES: All targets and rules will be in accordance with current ICFRA F-Class rules.
4. ENTRIES: All entries must be paid in advance. Complete entry forms on the enclosed Registration and Entry Form. The following payment methods may be used.

7. FOULING SHOTS: There will be a fouling (blow off) period before the start of fire each morning.
8. TARGET SERVICE: All competitors will be required to mark their own targets in practice and individual match days.

Wednesday 7th June 2017

Squadded practice.

Thursday 8th June 2017

Long Range Match – 2 sighters and 15 shots to count at 1100 & 1200 yards. The top 10 F-Open and F-TR competitors will compete in a final shoot-off. The final will consist of 2 sighters and 10 shots to count. Informal practice will be available in the afternoon.

Friday 9th June 2017

Emerald Individual Day 1 – 2 sighters and 15 shots to count at 800, 900 and 1000 yards.

Saturday 10th June 2017

Emerald Individual Day 2 – 2 sighters and 15 shots to count at 800, 900 and 1000 yards.

Sunday 11th June 2017

Emerald 4-Man International Team Match – 2 sighters and 15 shots to count at 800, 900 and 1000 yards. Teams will consist of four firing members, captain, coach and an alternate (if desired). Teams to be named by 4pm Saturday 10th June.

Awards Ceremony for Emerald Matches.

The Presentation/Barbecue will be held on Sunday afternoon. Details to follow.

12. RELOADING COMPONENTS – If reloading components are required, please contact Midlands National Shooting Centre or National Rifle Association of Ireland at jpcraven@eircom.net or info@nrai.ie. Components are still hard to find, but we will assist in any way we can.

13. IRISH FIREARMS PERMITS – The fee for an Irish visitors permit is €40. You may apply for the permit yourself, or each country (NRA) may appoint a nominee who will post all their completed forms and fees to the NRAI and the NRAI will lodge the applications with the Garda. Please allow 6 weeks for visitor permit applications.
