

YOUTH COMMITTEE

Policy:

The SSUSBC Youth Committee consists of 15 members appointed by the South Sound USBC President: with 4 elected youth directors automatically appointed to the youth committee

- Developing eligibility requirements for board members representing the youth.
- Electing a chair, co-chair and a recording secretary.
- Developing eligibility requirements for the Youth Committee, subject to approval of the board of directors:
 - Must be a USBC member.
 - Must be at least fourteen (14) years of age at the time that they take office.
 - Prior board experience is not required.
- Establishing a quorum for Youth Committee meetings – the SSUSBC Youth Committee quorum is eight (8).
- Committee meeting absenteeism: A Youth Committee member with four (4) absences, excused or unexcused, during the fiscal year is subject to possible removal from the committee upon committee review.
- Developing, monitoring, promoting, reviewing and recommending youth programs conducted by the association.
- Report to the board.

The term of office for Youth Committee members is 1 year.

Procedures:

- ◆ Meet once a month to review, develop, discuss and promote youth programs or issues.
- ◆ Submit articles for the newsletter issues or website on upcoming tournaments, tournament results and all-stars or youth information.
- ◆ Meet in January to recommend bylaw changes pertaining to Youth programs as indicated.
- ◆ Meet at other times as required by circumstances.
- ◆ Update the operations manual as needed and present proposed changes to Youth policies and procedures to the Governance Committee.
- ◆ Develop, review and maintain operations manual for youth program activities.
- ◆ Chairperson will make appointments to vacant committee positions with approval of the majority of the Youth committee.
