

QUILT IN A PILLOW

Supplies:

- 1 ½ yd of one fabric
- 1 ½ yd of a coordinating fabric
- ½ yd of fabric for pillow
- Batting (45 X 60)

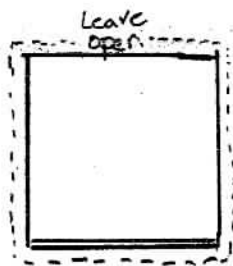
Instruction:

1. Lay fabric A right side up. Place fabric B right side to fabric A. Place batting on top. You should have a sandwich, which consists of fabric, fabric, and batting.
2. Stitch around 3 sides and on the fourth (short) stitch, lock stitch, then leave an opening of apx 12" then stitch remainder.
3. Clip corners diagonally.
4. Turn right side out.
5. Press under raw edges of opening 5/8 inch.

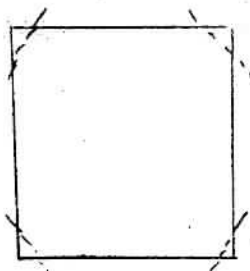
Pillow: Sew the two 18 X 18 squares right sides together. Leave an opening at one end for ease of turning. Clip corners, turn and press.

6. Place pillow on top of quilt with matching centers. Stitch pillow pocket to quilt on three sides. This will take care of the opening on both the pillow and quilt.
7. Stitch quilting lines the length of the quilt and even with pillow edges.

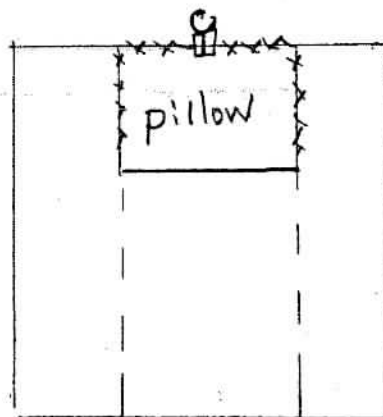
