DESCRIPTION: Other than the bow specs, there are no markings on this bow. I'm guessing this is a Ben Pearson Locksley Lion. Locksley was a mid-range Ben Pearson bow line that was marketed mostly to England and other European countries in the 1960s. This Locksley Lion reminds me of a super-charged Pearson Cougar. It is more substantial than the Cougar, and this one features tip overlays on both sides of the limb, which were rarely added to lower-end bows. Brown glass on the face and back. Comfortable pistol grip. No delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in good condition. No drilled holes. No stress lines or crazing. A few very small chips and dings. No cracks. A few scratches and scuffs. This is a nice bow in excellent condition for its age.
