Greetings fellow Voyageurs,

This is the time of year for warmer weather and days filled with more sunshine. As my father used to say, "Spring is here, and brings good cheer. Robins chirp, frogs burp."

I'd say Spring Cheminot was underwhelming in terms of attendance, but it really was the standard number of Voyageurs showing up — 27 made the trip to Brooklyn. It was nice to see a good number at the Grand Chef's Homecoming as well.

That's the (kind of) good news. Now for the not-so-good news.

Michigan's membership is only 78.87%. Only four other states in the 12-state Region 4 have a lower membership percentage than Michigan: Florida (77.95%), Massachusetts (72.28%), New York (78.54%) and Oklahoma (71.56%), per National Sous Directeur Membership Thomas Ressman

On average Michigan has 15 tornadoes per year. Tornadoes are known to develop rapidly, with little advanced warning.

The average lead time for a tornado warning is 10 to 15 minutes and winds can reach over 200 mph, which is why Michigan residents are encouraged to prepare and

make a plan before a tornado strikes.

Terms:

Tornado Watch: Tornadoes are possible. When there is a Watch, move near enough to a shelter or sturdy building to be able to get inside quickly if there is a Warning or if you see signs of a tornado approaching. Remain

alert for approaching storms. Watch the sky and stay tuned to NOAA Weather Radio, commercial radio or television for information.

Tornado Warning: A tornado has been sighted or indicated by weather radar. Take shelter immediately.

Nationally, Michigan is ranked 36th. Our state has a goal of 738 Voyageurs, with a current shortage of 190 members. Voitures Locale in Michigan at 100% are V-161, V-669, V-686, V-957, V-1002 and V-1116,. Voitures nearing 100% are V-102 (90.20%), V-181 (85.71%), V-396 (84.21%), V-545 (89.57%), V-600 (94.74%), V-746 (96.77%), V-767 (81.58%), V-946 (90.70%), V-997 (94.57%), V-1061 (96.15%), V-1288

V-1536 (89.29%). Let's crank it up a bit and push for 100% across the board!
I was given permission during Cheminot to send a mass mailing to Michigan's membership with information about Grand Promenade. I'll be working on that for the next few weeks. Sending out emails to those who have them and posting the information has been ineffective. You took an oath to attend all

Promenades, and Grand
