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BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Newton, Jasper County, Illinois that SECTION 38-1-14(A) be amended in its entirety to provide as follows:

38-1-14 CONNECTION PERMITS; FEES.

(A) The City Clerk is hereby authorized to grant such permits as the Clerk may deem proper, allowing persons to connect to the waterworks system and the sewerage system. The applicant shall pay for the material (which may include but not limited to, piping, fittings, the meter, backfill material, and/or boring under roads) required for installing the water service from the main to the premises in the manner prescribed by the City. The permit fee for the connection to the sewerage main shall be Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) refundable deposit, refundable upon inspection of completed project of the sewer connection. The City will provide the sewer connection fitting. This shall be installed by a licensed plumber in the manner prescribed by the City. The applicant shall have a licensed plumber install the sewer service from the main to the residence or premises in the manner prescribed by the City. The permit fees described above shall be paid into the waterworks fund or sewer fund. A connection (tapping) fee shall not be charged if the owner uses an existing connection to the water or sewer main. A connection (tapping) fee/deposit shall only be assessed when a new connection is being made.

Except as amended hereby, CHAPTER 38 UTILITIES shall remain in full force and effect according to its original terms.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
