2. Give number of animals and number of pens needed. Note any special request on entry form and Superintendent will try to comply.
3. All animals must be registered in the name of the exhibitor and registered with a National Registry.
4. All entry reports must be available the day of the show. Entry reports will be mailed or can be picked up before the fair starts.
5. Read the rules governing Livestock Exhibitors at Illinois Fairs in this book.
6. **All entries must be in place by 10:00 pm on Tuesday, July 9 and will be released on Thursday, July 11 after the show.**
7. This is a Sanctioned Show by the American Dairy Goat Association and their rules shall govern. Group classes are not sanctioned. Jr. and Sr. does are sanctioned separately for each show.
8. Judging Order: Wethers, followed by breed classes as listed. Breeds will be shown in the following order - Alpines, LaMancha, Nubian, Oberhasli, Saanen and all other pure breeds and recorded grades.
9. Any animals with ringworm or abscesses means the entire herd will be sent home. No refund of entry fees.
10. **Exhibitors will be assigned pens. Premium money may be withheld if changes are made without approval of the superintendents.**
11. **Health papers will be collected by superintendent upon goats arrival. They will be returned after examined by Vet and CVI is stamped. NO EXCEPTIONS!**
12. Livestock trailers must be parked in designated area. NO EXCEPTIONS!
13. No wash racks may be used in the building without the superintendents approval.
14. Show order not subject to change.
15. Wethers are not part of Sanctioned Show.
16. **NO DOGS ALLOWED!**
17. **All families who exhibit goats are asked to help clean out the barn when Dairy goats are released so the Meat goats can move in the next morning.**
18. **For ease of cleaning purposes, please use ONLY shavings (not straw) for bedding. Shavings may be available for purchase during the fair. Please check with the superintendents.**

- * Wether; 3-6 Months: Born 2/19 to 5/19
- * Wether; 6-9 Months: Born 11/18 to 2/19
- * Wether; 9-12 Months: Born 8/18 to 11/18

- * Junior Kid: Born on or after 4/1/19
- * Intermediate Kid: Born 3/1/19 to 3/31/19
- * Senior Kid: Born 1/1/19 to 2/28/19
- * Dry Yearling: Under 2, born before 7/2/18

- * Milking Yearling; Under 2 years, born before 7/02/18
- * Milker 2 years & under 3: 7/2/16 to 7/1/17
- * Milker 3 years & under 4: 7/2/15 to 7/1/16
- * Milker 4 years & under 5: 7/2/14 to 7/1/15
- * Milker 5 years & older: Born before 7/1/14

- * Group Classes: Animals must be owned by the same exhibitor unless otherwise stated. All animals must be shown in individual classes.
- * Produce of Dam: To consist of two does which are the offspring of one Dam.
- * Best Udder: Best udder in each individual breed.
- * Dam & Daughter: Any age, owned by one exhibitor, dam must be named and in milk.
- * Get of Sire: Consists of three does of any age, the offspring of one Sire. Animals need not be owned by the same exhibitor.
- * Breeder's Trio: To consist of three does any age bred and owned by one exhibitor.

IL STATE RULE 260.95 Junior classes are open to boys and girls who are eight (8) years of age and not yet 19 years of age on or before September 1 of the year previous to the Fair. All animals shown in junior classes must be the property of the boys and girls showing them. If the same animals are shown in both the open classes and junior classes, they shall be shown under the same exhibitor's name.
