Why native plants?

- -Native habitats provide food and shelter for birds, turtles, bees, bats, butterflies and other wildlife.
- -Habitat loss is the chief cause of species decline; Natives are the bedrock for bringing species back.
- -Native plants adapt to local climate-no need for herbicides/pesticides/fertilizer.
- -Most are perennials-no need to buy and replant each year.
- -Natives host butterfly breeding grounds. (Monarch numbers are down by more than 80%!)
- -Natives provide garden color, soil retention and long bloom seasons. They're natural beauties!
