

### GIVE YOURSELF AWAY

Paul says that he is free. He is not a slave and he has freedom. But look at verse 19. He makes himself a slave to everyone in order to win more people: I have freedoms but I do not use them for the sake of the gospel. To the Jews and to the Gentiles I understand where they are coming from in order to win them. I become all things to all people so that by all means possible I might save some.

This is the heart of the gospel: IT IS NOT ABOUT ME! Everything is for the sake of the gospel, not me. Think about the gospel. When we talk to each other, think about what we are saying for the sake of the gospel. Are we trying to understand where a person is coming from and truly helping them see the glory of Jesus, or are we just coming from our knowledge and our 'superior position' and going to tell them what they *should* think, say, or do? Consider their background and reach them with the gospel where they are. Do not be a stumbling block in their path to Jesus. We must think this way with unbelievers, weaker Christians, and stronger Christians.

Think about what Paul says in verse 19. We make ourselves a servant of all.

We are to give ourselves away to others.

The goal is not ourselves and not our rights and freedoms. The goal is the gospel of Jesus Christ. I do it all for the sake of the gospel, that I may share with them in its blessings. (1 Corinthians 9:23 ESV)
