

Riverside Park Campground 2021 Seasonal Camping Rules

1. Property quiet hours are between 11:00 PM and 8:00 AM. No noise should be heard from your campsite. Intoxication, noise after quiet hours, damage to facilities, vandalism, or repeated visits by staff, to enforce rules, will not be tolerated. Misbehavior from seasonal campers or their guests, anywhere on the property, will be grounds for eviction with no refund.
2. We want everyone to have an enjoyable time and be safe when on the property; underage alcohol consumption or public intoxication by anyone will not be tolerated. Alcohol is allowed in the campground, but open containers are only allowed on individual sites. No carrying of bottles or cans (identifiable as alcohol), throughout the park or pool area. These must be placed in a plastic cup.
3. Campers under the age of 16 must be on their family's campsite between the hours of 9:00 PM and 7:00 AM and be accompanied by an adult if they leave their campsite during these hours. An adult must accompany children under 6 at all times when not on their campsite.
4. The play area is designed for children 12 and under and is closed from 9:00 pm. To 8:00 a.m.
5. Campfires must be confined in an approved fireplace. The flame height of fires will not exceed 24" above the base of the ground. Foraging for wood, cutting trees, removing branches or other vegetation for burning is not permitted. In accordance with state law, firewood is not to be brought into the campground from out of the State of Maine.
6. When leaving for the more than the day, please turn off your water connection and air conditioners in your camper. Please maintain your campsite in clean and orderly condition. Place all trash in the dumpster. Only wood is to be burned on your campsite. Do not dispose of trash, plastic items, bottles, cans or other waste by burning in the fireplace.
7. You are responsible for mowing. Sites not mowed will be cut by campground staff. A \$30 fee will be charged.
8. You have paid for one campsite for your camping unit and cars. Cars that do not fit on your site can not be parked on roads or unoccupied campsites and are to be parked in the overflow parking lot on Route 1 on a first-come, first-served basis. Please come to the office, prior to parking in the Route 1 lot, to receive a parking pass. The speed limit in the campground is 5 mph (or less) at all times.
9. It is not permitted to walk through or cut through an occupied or unoccupied campsite. Please stay on the paved roads.
10. As the seasonal tenant of your campsite, you are responsible for monitoring and controlling the conduct of everyone present on your site. We do ask that you stop by the office and advise us of expected guests. You will be provided with a window sticker identifying your car as a seasonal vehicle. All guests must stop at the office and receive a parking pass when entering the property. Guests must leave quietly before 11:00 PM or pay a \$5 per person overnight stay charge. Family members are allowed to stay overnight at no additional charge. If a guest (non-family member) stays overnight, the primary seasonal camper (whose name appears on the contract) must also be present for the night.
- 10 Your pets are welcomed in the campground. Guests are not permitted to bring in pets. You are responsible for your pets conduct and for picking up after them. We require a current rabies and distemper certificate be presented for pets at the start of each season, please bring these to the office on your first visit in the spring. We require that a waste disposal bag or device be carried whenever exercising/walking your pet and that you use it to remove all pet waste and deposit it in the dumpster immediately. We will continue to admit pets but will not tolerate abuse of this privilege by any seasonal resident. Pets will be restrained and under control at all times. If they are tied-out on your site, the lead must be short enough to confine them to within two feet of the site boundaries. If your pet appears to be aggressive, or is digging, you will be asked to confine it in your camping unit except when being exercised. Children who walk pets must be able to control them and pick up their waste. You will be liable for any damage or injury caused by your pet. It is distressing to listen to pets that have been left at your campsite. If your dog is heard barking or whining during your absence, you will be asked to come to the office upon your return to assure they are not left unattended again.
- 11 There is NO lifeguard on duty at the pool. You are swimming at your own risk and agree to comply with all posted rules for that area. No food, glass, or smoking, are allowed in the pool area. An adult, 18 or over, must accompany children under 16 while in the pool. Swim diapers are required for children who are not toilet trained. Pets are not allowed in the pool area. Everyone must shower before entering the water.
- 12 The campground is personal property and we do not allow fireworks, firearms, or any weapons or illegal drugs to be brought onto the property.
- 13 The Riverside Park Campground, LLC (Campground) as the operator of the facility, is not responsible for damage to your personal property. Please assure adequate insurance coverage for your camping unit and that your homeowner's policy provides coverage for accidental injuries which occur on your campsite. The seasonal camper(s) whose name(s) appear(s) on the annual contract, accepts occupancy of their campsite with agreement that he/she does release the Campground, its officers and employees of all liability for loss of or damage to property or injury to his/her person, family members or guests arising out of his/her use of its facilities, and agrees to indemnify the Campground, its officers and employees, against claims resulting from loss or damage to property or injury to his/her person, family member or guest of the registered camper arising out of the use of its facilities.
- 14 Please respect your fellow campers and treat them as you want to be treated. We feel that our rules are simple and reasonable and are intended to assure everyone has a safe, pleasant and relaxing outdoor experience.
