Michigan started registering cars in 1905, and the plates were simply an license plates for automobiles. Plates got larger as more numbers and letters were needed as the number of registered cars grew. Half year plates were issued during the Depression since money was scarce to most families. 1960 was the first year tags were used with the prior year plates. (This only lasted a few years.) There were 3 pages of interesting history and facts about license plates that Doug handed out to everyone. I know I learned a lot! Thanks Doug!
