A meal was shared starting at 3:10.

The meeting was called to order at 3:52 p.m. by President Dean Jessup.

- The **Meeting Minutes** from the July 17, 2021 meeting were reviewed with no questions or revisions. Moved to approve by Steve S., supported by Rob B. Motion carried unanimously.
- **Treasurer's Report**: Dean J. presented the report prepared by Patsy G. The PSA had a strong year financially, ending with a checkbook balance of approximately \$4,900. Steve S. moved, supported by Dan G., to accept the Treasurer's Report as presented. Motion carried unanimously.
- **Membership Update**. Dean J. presented the report from Bruce Koorndyk. The PSA currently has 80 members, which is up from last year.
- PSA Clothing: Dan G. reported that sales were down slightly this year, but PSA has a good inventory going into next year.
- Lyn Snider gave a recap of **the Ladies Classic** which was held on July 31, 2021. It was a great event with good participation and nice catches. Due to strong support from sponsors in the community, some funds were able to be returned to the PSA.
- Dean J. gave an update on the installation of the **channel lights**. PSA received \$700 from the Pentwater Lake Association to pay for 50% of the costs of the lights.
- Dean J. reported that the **fish cleaning station** at the Village Marina is once again operational. The PSA has donated over \$2000 to the village for the cleaning station, and has \$395 to donate this year.
- Dean J. presented a "2021 Year in Review".
- 1. Director Elections: Steve Sauser and Rob Bannink's terms as Directors expired this year. Dan G. reported on behalf of the Nominating Committee that Steve and Rob are nominated for another three-year term. Dean J. invited members to make nominations from the floor. No additional nominations were made. Dan G. motioned, supported by David V., that Steve Sauser and Rob Bannink be elected to a three-year term on the Board of Directors. Motion carried unanimously

August Mini Tournament 2021 Results

The PSA mini-tournament took place as scheduled on Saturday, August 21. The weather is always a consideration and that Saturday was no exception. Wind and waves were abundant. There were eleven boats in the contest and ten weighed in fish. The category that paid the most money this time around was the Most Fish, which was won by Bret Almashie's boat, Trips To Win. They caught a total of ten fish and one of two boats that had the limit of ten fish to weigh. Trips To Win had 107.95 lbs of fish and the other boat with ten fish to weigh, Breakaway, had a respectable 92.20 lbs of fish. Nice catches gentlemen!!

Second place money went to Big Fish, caught by the Producer Fishing Team weighing 28.6 lbs. Third place money went to Mystery Weight, a weight closest to the previously selected weight of 5.2. Breakaway managed to bring in a fish weighing 5.5 lbs in their ten-fish catch and won the third place money.

Total weight of fish caught in this event was 553.05. Congratulations to all for a great time!!

The next event on the PSA calendar was the Bannick's Lines Down end of season Tournament. Our thanks goes to the Bannick family that puts this event on each year and returns a portion of the entry money to the PSA. The remainder of the entry money goes for prizes, both cash and door prizes.

Saturday September 4, 2021

The Pentwater Sportfishing Association (PSA) and the Bannick family held the seventh annual "Bannink's End of Summer Lines Down" fishing tournament Saturday, September 4th. Twenty-one boats participated and over 425 pounds of fish were caught. Prizes were awarded to the crew of "Pentwater Haze" (with captain Rick Czajkowski) who secured the largest King Salmon weighing in at 22.05 pounds. The heaviest trout was a Lake Trout weighing 18.35 pounds brought in by "Lyme Time" (captained by Steve Weber). The heaviest combination weight (of salmon and trout) was also awarded to "Lyme Time" with their top three fish weighing in at 47.45 pounds. The crew from "Producer" (with captain Lyn Snider) won closest mystery weight category with a 3.85 pound King Salmon. Cash prizes were awarded and all participants received consolation prizes.
