#### **Application Period Closes November 1 for Certified Healthy Oklahoma Programs**

All organizations who wish to be part of *Certified Health Oklahoma* programs have until Tuesday, November 1 to submit applications for 2016. The Certified Healthy Early Childhood Program recognizes early childhood programs that are providing a healthy environment for children and their families, as well as their staff. Criteria details and application information for all *Certified Healthy* Oklahoma programs are now available on the Certified Healthy Oklahoma website at www.certifiedhealthvok.com. Each program has three levels of certification: Basic, Merit and Excellence. Award winners will be notified in December and acknowledged at an awards ceremony in March. The Certified Healthy Oklahoma programs are a joint effort of the Oklahoma State Department of Health, The State Chamber, The Oklahoma Academy, Oklahoma Turning Point Council, and numerous other partners who are helping to shape a healthier future for Oklahoma.

## **Child Care Subsidy Policy Revised**

Effective 10/1/16, Child Care Subsidy policy is revised to include 12 month eligibility periods. This means in most cases, families will maintain child care assistance at the current level for 12 months even when the parent loses his or her need factor. The new policy revisions reflect changes required by the reauthorization of the Child Care and Development Block Grant (CCDBG), the main funding source for the Child Care Subsidy program. With the change in federal law, states are required to focus on the child's developmental needs in addition to the family's efforts at becoming self-supporting. Approving families for 12 month eligibility periods will support healthy child development by allowing for continuity of care and stability of child care placement. ## Healthy Active Living Learning Collaborative

**Call for Applications!** 

One in four U.S. children under age 5 is either overweight or obese. These children experience greater school absenteeism, miss learning opportunities, and have increased medical costs. Early education centers have a chance to support national obesity prevention efforts through interventions and supportive policies that promote nutrition and physical activity. The National Center on Early Childhood Health and Wellness (NCECHW) is now accepting applications from programs to participate in a Learning Collaborative process. This professional development initiative will give 10 teams the chance to implement healthy active living interventions in their program.

#### About the Learning Collaborative

Participants will engage in two in-person trainings to build fundamental knowledge and skills. Activities will promote team building and peer-to-peer learning for healthy active living initiatives around several areas. These include staff wellness, nutrition education, physical activity, and family engagement.

In addition, quarterly virtual training and technical assistance will be offered between learning sessions. Teams will use an action planning process to improve program quality. The teams will participate in a final in-person session in order to document successes, best practices, barriers, and implementation strategies.

#### Who Should Apply?

Head Start, Early Head Start, child care, family child care, and preschool programs are eligible to apply. This training is open to programs with previous experience in implementing policies and practices related to healthy active living, as well as those programs seeking to begin this work in this area.

#### The Application Process

Selected programs will receive \$3,000 each to assist with the costs of facilitating activities that focus on programmatic and policy interventions. For more details about the award, please:
