





The impossible happened...

You've probably seen pictures or heard of "The Beast" the fire that burned part of Fort McMurray earlier this month. 2,500 houses were destroyed and many more have probably sustained damage. Nobody could have imagined that this would ever happen! It's nearly been a month and it still seems impossible!

While we moved out of the community last November to come closer to family, we still own a house in Fort McMurray and we have several close friends who have lost everything! Just like that. Gone...



Some people knew exactly what their house insurance covers, some had a list of all the items in the house that would be claimed... while some had let their insurance lapse and now have nothing left, and no support to get back on their feet.

Now what would you say the probability of your house burning down in a fire is? What do you think those who lost their homes in the fire would have said their probability was a month ago? And yet, 2,500 families are suffering that exact loss, that impossible loss.

Let me give you one certainty: we are all going to die some day... we don't know when. It might be next week, it might be in 60 years (I want the second number). But the bottom line is that it is going to happen. So now that the importance of home insurance is pretty obvious to most people, how about your coverage for life insurance? Do you have any insurance? Do you have enough insurance? Can you afford not to? Loosing a house is one thing, loosing the main bread winner or the main caretaker is a whole different story.
