




The legal voters of the Town of Ira, Vermont are hereby warned and notified to meet at the Ira Town Hall on Monday, March 5, 2018 at 7:30 pm for an informational hearing and to act on Articles 2 -13, and to meet again at the Town Office, on Tuesday, March 6, 2018 between 10:00 am and 7:00 pm, to act on Article 1 by Australian Ballot.

Article 1.	To Elect Town Officers as required by State statute
Article 2.	To act on the reports of the Town Officers
Article 3.	Shall the voters authorize payment of real and personal property taxes to the Town Treasurer on or before October 23, 2018?
Article 4.	Shall the voters authorize the total expenditure of \$249,103 for the Town General Fund and Highway Fund for the fiscal year 7/1/18-6/30/19, for which \$187,203 will be raised by taxes and \$61,900 shall be from non-tax revenue?
Article 5.	Shall the voters appropriate \$7,645.60 to be raised by taxes for the Rutland County Sheriff's Department, in addition to \$12,000 included in the Town General Fund expenditures in Article 4 above for a total of \$19,645.60?
Article 6.	Shall the voters appropriate \$35,257 to be raised by taxes for the support of the Ira Volunteer Fire Department to provide services to the residents of Ira?
Article 7.	Shall the voters appropriate \$2,925 to be raised by taxes for the support of the Rutland Free Library to provide services to residents of Ira?
Article 8.	Shall the voters appropriate \$973 to be raised by taxes for the support the Rutland Area Visiting Nurse Association and Hospice to provide services to residents of the town?
Article 9.	Shall the voters appropriate \$300 to be raised by taxes for support of Southwestern Vermont Council on Aging to provide elder services to residents of the Town?
Article 10.	Shall the voters appropriate \$286 to be raised by taxes for the support of Rutland Mental Health Services so that these services can be maintained?
Article 11.	Shall the voters appropriate \$375 to be raised by taxes to support The RSVP & The Volunteer Center in 2018 (Retired and Senior Volunteer Program)?
Article 12.	Shall the voters appropriate \$250 to be raised by taxes to support BROCC – Community Action in Southwestern Vermont in 2018-2019?
Article 13.	To transact any other legal and proper business to come before this meeting.
