### What's Happening?

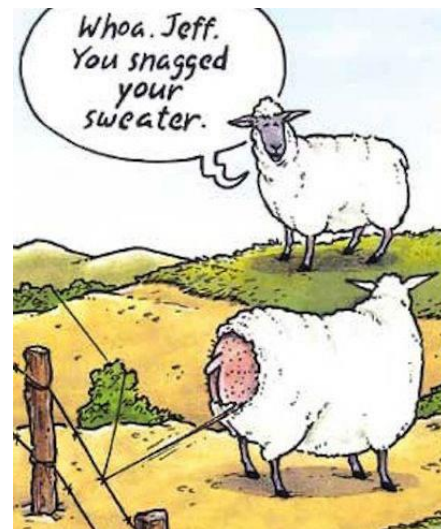
- Two new LED lamps were installed for Lectors and for the church organ.
