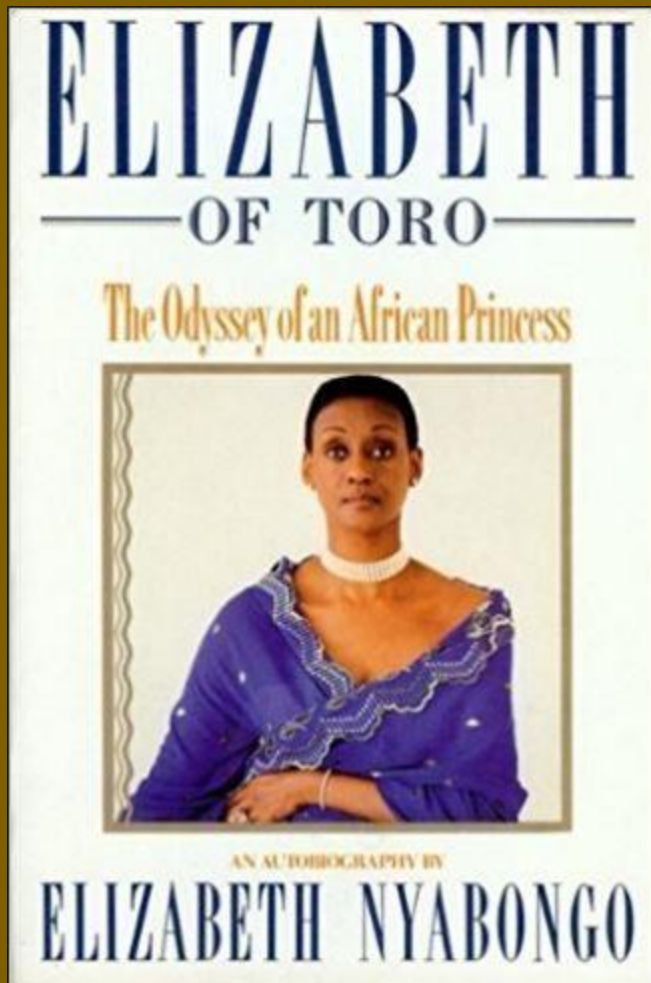


This is a great firsthand account of Uganda's change from kingdoms through British colonialism and Amin. It focuses mostly
