
To put into perspective.....

2023-2024 Faith Development / Family Catechism Registration

Our faith development/family catechism is for families with children ages 6-12 who have been baptized in the Catholic faith. The sessions are for both the parent & child as our program involves interaction between parent & child. We ask that if the parent is not available, the child attend with an adult they are comfortable with. We meet bi-weekly for 1.5 hours and our program uses music, videos, slides, crafts & games to engage the children in developing their faith.



The faith development/family catechism program is the structure that helps to form the children's faith especially those that will be receiving sacraments. Please know that all children must have at least one year of faith development/family catechism prior to preparing to receive a sacrament.

Registrations for the bi-weekly sessions of faith development / family catechism for St. Augustine's or St. Lawrence O'Toole will be taking place on Sunday, September 10th from 12:15 – 1:30 pm in the church basement of St. Augustine's.

You can submit the form online or print the form (using the word or pdf document) and drop it off at our office or in the collection basket at mass.

All families must be pre-registered in order to attend the sessions.


Registrations for all sacraments will be held at a later date.




