## The Yearbooks Are Here!

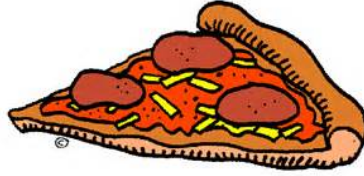
