Recipe of the Month

Left Over Turkey Soup

- 2 cloves garlic, chopped finely
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 1 chopped onion
- 1 carrot, finely chopped
- 1 stalk celery, finely chopped
- 1 tablespoon chopped fresh sage leaves (optional)
- 2 (32 ounce) cartons chicken broth
- 1 bay leaf
- 2 cups green beans, cut into 1 inch pieces
- 1 sweet potato, diced
- 1/2 cup uncooked small pasta
- 3 cups diced, cooked turkey meat

In a large soup pot, slightly brown garlic in the olive oil, add onion, carrot and celery. Cook on medium-low till tender. Add the chopped sage to the soup pot along with the broth and the bay leaf. Bring to a simmer. When simmering, add the green beans, sweet potato, and pasta to the soup. Bring it back up to a simmer; lower heat and cook for about 10 minutes or until vegetables are tender and pasta is cooked. Stir in turkey. Turn the heat off. Cover, and allow to sit and steam for 5-7 minutes.
