

OVERALL FINDINGS-DEMOGRAPHICS

- Youngest is 19; Oldest is 65
- Average age is: 36
- 68% Male; 32% Female
- 49% Hispanic; 24% African American; 17% White; 1% Native American; 6% Multi Racial; 3% Other (Caribbean)
- 50% MSM; 50% Heterosexual
- 82% HIV Dx; 12% AIDS Dx


HOW DID YOU FIND OUT YOU WERE HIV+

How did you find out you were HIV positive?





(Please check all that apply.)





How long do you think you may have been HIV positive (living with HIV) before you received your first positive test?




IF YOU DELAYED GETTING TESTED FOR HIV, WHAT WERE YOUR REASONS FOR NOT GETTING TESTED?


WHAT CLINIC/DOCTOR'S OFFICE DO YOU GO TO FOR YOUR HIV?

What would have helped you to get tested for HIV sooner? (Please check all that apply.)




HISPANIC SURVEY RESPONSE DETAIL

HISPANIC FINDINGS-DEMOGRAPHICS


- Average age is: 33
- 66% Male; 34 % Female
- 50% MSM; 40% Heterosexual; 2% Sex with Drug User; 8% Other (rape, transfusion)
- 81 % HIV+; 19% AIDS
- 65% of Hispanic survey respondents diagnosed with an STD
- Total responses: 35 (50% of responses)

HISPANIC DETAIL: HOW DID YOU FIND OUT YOU WERE HIV+




HISPANIC DETAIL: HOW MANY TIMES WERE YOU TESTED FOR HIV BEFORE YOU TESTED POSITIVE

How many times were you tested for HIV before you tested positive?







AFRICAN AMERICAN FINDINGS-DEMOGRAPHICS


- Average age is: 37
- 59% Male; 41% Female
- 41% MSM; 53% Heterosexual; 6% Sex with Drug User;
- 88% HIV Dx; 12% AIDS Dx
- 59% of AA Respondents diagnosed with an STD
- Total responses: 17 (24% of responses)



How many times were you tested for HIV before you tested positive?








MEN WHO HAVE SEX WITH MEN (MSM) SURVEY RESPONSE DETAIL

MSM FINDINGS-DEMOGRAPHICS


- Average age is: 33
- 49% Hispanic; 20% African American; 17% White; 3% Native American; 6% Multi-Racial; 5% Other (Caribbean)
- 79% HIV Dx; 21% AIDS Dx
- 59% of MSM Respondents diagnosed with an STD
- 17% have private insurance (highest of any SNG)
- Total responses: 35 (50% of responses)

MSM DETAIL: HOW DID YOU FIND OUT YOU WERE HIV+




MSM DETAIL: HOW MANY TIMES WERE YOU TESTED FOR HIV BEFORE YOU TESTED POSITIVE

How many times were you tested for HIV before you tested positive?





RECOMMENDATIONS

- Work with Quality Improvement to determine Newly Diagnosed “Pathways to Care” by Severe Need Group
- Fund Medical Case Management in the Emergency Departments (EDs)—pilot at highest incidence locations
- Collaborate with PMC providers to develop a risk screening tool for EDs
- Determine “continuum of care” for newly diagnosed and ensure capacity exists
- Further enhance linkages between Counseling & Testing sites to ensure transition from positive test to entry into Primary Medical Care
- Utilize Early Intervention Services funding to have Part A Disease Intervention Specialists at STD testing sites
- Focus on STD screenings during QI site visits to ensure benchmarks are being achieved
- Involvement with HIV Prevention to utilize Newly Diagnosed survey data to “craft testing messages”
