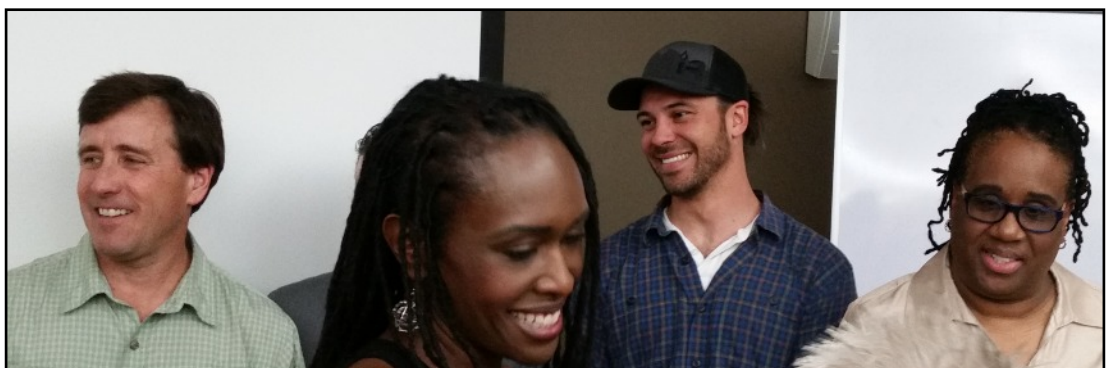

Heroes of Ohiopyle



In 2017, Patrick McCarty (Laurel Highland River Tours) and Eric Martin (Wilderness Voyageurs) of Ohiopyle, risked their lives in a harrowing rescue in high water without safety gear. Martin didn't even have a boat on hand. He ran to a nearby car and grabbed a kayak, a move that saved Annette Johnson of Philadelphia from drowning. Martin had no tight skirt on the boat, meaning that if she grabbed hold of the kayak and rolled him, they would both go over the Youghiogheny River's roaring Ohiopyle Falls.

While receiving medals from the Carnegie Hero Fund at a ceremony held at the Ohiopyle State Park Visitor Center, McCarty thanked Scott Patton for nominating them. McCarty, who brought Raecyne Bechtold of Connellsville, PA to safety just above the falls, humbly states that they were in the right place at the right time. But the truth is, non swimmer Johnson and old friend Bechtold could not have been rescued by more experienced river-men. Luck was on their side.

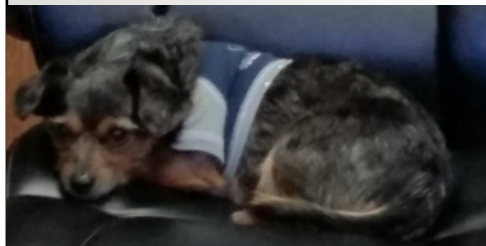

In March, the first stop on my 4 - site Ohiopyle Vacation Rentals tour was the homey **Buzzard's Cabin** on Nelson Road in Farmington, PA.

I took advantage of the eat in kitchen. Buzzards offers plenty of windows and light in a handy location just a few miles from both Ohiopyle and Route 40.

For those of us who appreciate simplicity, the freedom in it, Buzzards Cabin is your spot. *I loved the coziness of this cabin, the hot tub and fire pit.*



I had not stayed in a rustic cabin for some time. My favorite things were the gas stove and the Grizzly and Black bears hanging on the walls. The comfortable haven has all the basics including Internet.

When you head down the dirt lane to **Stoney Creek Lodge**, Farmington, PA, you know you just found peace. Enjoying the huge deck overlooking the wide bubbling stream is well worth the trip in itself.



Stoney Creek is three levels of fun with great lighting. I love the long dining table and water view. The big kitchen offers families a unique, private setting for reunions & weddings.



Riverfront, Confluence, PA - You can see how anyone coming to the area to bike, paddle or hike would benefit from this location. The Youghiogheny River bike trail bridge entrance is just outside the door at Riverfront, so is the river. The double decked porch overlooks the water, with a line up of white rocking chairs so your entire family can chill out together. When I arrived, I watched two men fly fishing and bikes were heading in both directions on the trail. Riverfront has a circular kitchen and dining area, a deck out back with adjacent large hot tub and picnic area.



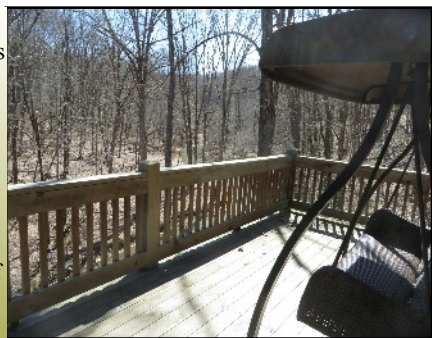
If I had to choose my favorite of the four Ohiopyle Vacation Rental homes I visited, it would be the **Chief Nemacolin Retreat**, Farmington, PA, due to the covered porch swinging on the high deck overlooking Stoney Creek.
