Jesus Saw, Part 2 July 2017 Sermon Series

Matthew continues to record every time that Jesus "saw" something or someone that made the Savior take notice...and do something. This month, we'll see him with Peter's mother-in-law (wait...Peter was MARRIED???), a growing mega-church that he ruins their attendance, faithful friends, snobby church people, and a woman who has lost it all - especially hope.

July 2 Jesus Heals Matt 8:14-17 Can you imagine getting sick thousands of years ago? No flu shots, no headache medicine, and the surgical procedures? No thanks! For many of us, we don't have to imagine getting sick...we are. Jesus, we are told, came to heal our diseases. He does that for Peter's mother-in-law, and many others...what about you, you ask? You might be surprised by the answer.

July 9Jesus HarshMatt 8:18-22Can you imagine a pastor that would tell a prominent lawyer (\$\$\$\$)
and an earnest young Christian to just go away? (Bet that pastor
would be looking for a job quickly, right?) And yet, that is essentially
what Jesus tells people in today's story, with some really harsh words.
Whatever happened to "Jesus meek and mild"?

July 16 Jesus Heals (AGAIN!) Matt 9:1-8 Jesus gets in trouble with the church...for healing a man, but not of what you think. His patient? A man that couldn't walk, so Jesus heals his heart. (Um, thanks?) Then angry at the church's response, he heals the man's legs! Maybe we need a little more of angry Jesus in our churches after all.

July 23Jesus HearsMatt 9:9-13Matthew shows up in his own story of Jesus! A haunting past doesn't
keep Matthew from following Jesus...and throwing him one party.A party that churchy people do not approve of, and not just because
of the tax collector's past...it's all "those" people that are there, that
good little church going Jesus shouldn't be associated with. Wait until
you see Jesus' response when he hears that mentioned! Are hurting
people with shady pasts welcome to meet Jesus at JRCC?

The Murrays' goal is that all of these children have a safe and nurturing home and come to a personal relationship with Jesus Christ.
