SUBJECT: Dade County AGRI Council Scholarships and Fellowships

I am pleased to announce, five fellowships/scholarships are available from the Dade County AGRI Council for the current academic year (see AGRI Council Scholarships details). Full-time students conducting research directly related to Miami-Dade agriculture are eligible to apply. All awards provide a stipend of \$500. Students may apply for all the awards that are applicable to their research but should not expect to receive more than one. An additional scholarship from the TREC Mango Forum (\$500) will be awarded to a student working on tropical fruit, particularly mango. No additional application is required to be considered for the TREC Mango Forum award.

To apply, complete the application form (2020 AGRI Council scholarship application form) and submit a supporting letter from a member of your Graduate Advisory Committee. It is not necessary to include transcripts of coursework. Please send your application to Dr. Mannion, cmannion@ufl.edu. Please put **AGRI Council Scholarship** in the subject line of your email.
