

VICTIM INDICATORS

- Signs of injury, fatigue, malnourishment, and/or unkempt or provocative clothing
- Acts intimidated or frightened of male in car
- Lack of eye contact with law enforcement
- Hesitant to answer law enforcement questions
- Unable to provide simple answers
- Unsure of current city/state and unable to answer detailed questions about whereabouts and activity during previous days
- Does not possess ID
- Refers to male occupant as "boyfriend" with no detailed information about him

TRAFFICKER INDICATORS

- Has large amounts of unexplained money/ gift cards
- Does not know female occupants names and backgrounds
- Provides conflicting or inaccurate information about female occupants
- Possesses multiple cellular phones
- Has tattoos referring to pimping
- Male speaks on behalf of female occupants
- Refers to occupants as girlfriends
- Driving vehicle from car rental company
- Male occupant is referred to as "mack," "daddy," or "boyfriend"

TRAFFIC STOP INDICATORS

- One male occupant and multiple unrelated females
- More luggage in vehicle than needed for length of trip
- Identification from various states
- Occupants do not know each other's full names or background
- More cell phones than occupants
- Provocative clothing and condoms in vehicle
- Occupants have conflicting stories about where they have traveled and activity during previous days
- Hotel passkeys found in vehicle

FOLLOW-UP STEPS for OFFICERS

- Separate all occupants to avoid coached answers
- Ask female occupants detailed questions and look for conflicting information
- Ask for origins of tattoos and/or injuries
- Ask for and document all phone numbers
- Ask female(s) (once separated) if they want to leave the male occupant
- Detail all information from traffic stop in field interview (FI) report for corroboration purposes
- If necessary, contact federal law enforcement regarding traffic stop
