ONLY BOW HUNTING IS PERMITTED.

NO FIREARMS OF ANY KIND.

ALL STATE OF OHIO HUNTING REGULATIONS INCLUDING, A HUNTING LICENSE MUST BE FOLLOWED

A COPY OF THE PERMIT MUST BE CARRIED BY EACH HUNTER AND IF PARKING IN THE MEADOW, A COPY MUST BE IN THE VEHICLE VISIBLE THROUGH THE WINDSHIELD.

HUNTING IS ONLY ALLOWED IN THE LARGE DEEP WOODS AT THE WEST END OF THE PROPERTY.

(The best way to get there is to follow the Main Trail west along the north side of the Meadow until it turns south.)

VEHICLES WITHOUT THE PROPER PERMITS WILL BE REPORTED TO THE SHERIFF.

Please be aware that hunting is a sensitive subject in the community and that any violation of the rules could jeopardize the hunting privileges for everyone.

(See Backside for Other Restrictions)

The following restrictions must be followed.

- 1. The Deep Woods is common ground, therefore;
 - a) It is for the enjoyment of all residents, at all times. Extreme care must be taken when hunting in the area.
 - b) No cutting or clearing of any type without Board Approval.
- 2. AWPOA abides by the rules for hunting on public land, therefore;
 - a) Baiting and/or otherwise feeding of deer or any other animal in and/or near the allowed hunting area is prohibited.
- 3. So that residents do not feel intimidated or uncomfortable when they are walking or riding the trails, no cameras are allowed to be setup to establish where deer or any other animal is located. Cameras are allowed to be carried for personal picture taking.
- 4. Tree stands are allowed with the following restrictions;
 - a) The bottom section of the ladder must be high enough (recommend 6') off the ground to prevent small children from climbing on them.
 - b) The stands must be removed at the end of the bow hunting season.
