Nikki was the only student in her class focused on hair extensions which created a following and eventually landed her a job at a reputable salon in South Orange, NJ. While working at that salon, Nikki grew a high-end, celebrity based clientele, eventually becoming the youngest stylist to hold a contract with the prestigious Jack and Jill of America, New Jersey Chapter. Nikki used her styling background in various art-based arenas. In the early 90's she became well acknowledged for her fashion-show appearances in both New York and New Jersey which led to her being awarded the title of Miss New Jersey in an international St. Martin based beauty and talent pageant. Staying true to her love for the performing arts, Nikki attended various acting schools back in her home state of New York where she studied under prestigious coaches in their own rights, such as the legendary Carol Rosenfeld of HB Studios. "Center Screen Entertainment" and in 2005 she produced the first-ever behind-the-scene

television special for the National Black Theatre Festival in North Carolina. The festival

attracted thousands of influential artists and gained the support of Dr. Maya Angelou, Ruby Dee and Ossie Davis, August Wilson, and Oprah Winfrey. Tonya relocated to New York and in 2003, she produced the television series, 'Uptown Flavor TV" which showcased various elements and areas of Harlem, a historic community in New York City, described by some as the mecca for Black culture in the United States. Tonya is also an accredited actress. She has worked with several prestigious NY theatre companies including Douglas Turner Ward's Negro Ensemble Company. She received recognition for her performance as Rosa Parks in the National Theatre of the Performing Arts production of The Rosa Parks

Story. She has also appeared in various independent films including the feature film,

"Sophisticated Romance".
