2. Ordinance No. 1 of 2020

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 14 OF 2017 TO PROVIDE FOR INCREASES IN SEWER CHARGES BEGINNING APRIL 1, 2020, AND OTHERWISE PROVIDING WITH RESPECT THERETO

Town Clerk, Veronica Brown read the Ordinance by Title and explained that there would be a two (2) percent increase in the sewer rates and this reading would be to introduce and set for a Public Hearing on Monday, March 16th. A motion was made by Alderman Robinson seconded by Alderman Larsen to approve Ordinance No. 1 of 2020. The motion was carried by unanimous voice vote.

Public Comments:

Mr Carter Bedford, Greenwood resident inquired on the amount that the 2% sewer increase would reflect, Town Clerk Veronica Brown advised that she would provide to the Board and public.

Alderman Larsen inquired on an update for the sewage overflow that affected three houses on Blake St., Mayor Frank gave an update on the clean up and remediation. He also advised of the Preventative & Maintenance programs that will be implemented on Kelly Ln, Knotty Oak, Bea and Blake as well as maintenance on Lift stations

Alderman Smith, inquired on Bruckner Trucking following through on its promise to plant trees as a noise barrier, Mayor Frank responded accordingly
