## 2018 Show Classification Schedule

### RIBBON JUDGING CLASSES

#### A. Open Competition

1. Orchid plants in flower, arranged for effect, 25 square feet maximum.
2. Orchid plants in flower, arranged for effect, 50 square feet maximum.
3. Orchid Plants in flower, arranged for effect, more than 50 square feet.
4. Other exhibits, no space limitations. (Examples might include: Educational exhibits, Cut Flowers arranged for effect, orchid related materials arranged for effect, etc.).

#### B. Orchid Societies affiliated with the American Orchid Society

5. Orchid plants in flower, arranged for effect, 25 square feet maximum.
6. Orchid plants in flower, arranged for effect, 50 square feet maximum.
7. Orchid plants in flower, arranged for effect, more than 50 square feet.

#### C. Amateur Competition

8. Orchid plants in flower, arranged for effect, 25 square feet maximum.
9. Orchid plants in flower, arranged for effect, more than 25 square feet.
- 9a. Orchid plants in flower, arranged for effect, 1 to 5 plants.
- 9b. Orchid plants in flower, arranged for effect, 6 to 10 plants.

#### D. Cattleya Alliance

10. Encyclia, Epidendrum and Prosthechea species.
11. Encyclia, Epidendrum and Prosthechea hybrids and intergenerics, but excluding Cattleya and Guarianthe.
12. Brassavola (including Rhyncholaelia) species, hybrids and intergenerics other than above, excluding Cattleya and Guarianthe.
13. Broughtonia species, hybrids and intergenerics other than above, but excluding Cattleya and Guarianthe.
14. Traditional Laelia and Sophronitis species, hybrids and intergenerics other than above, but excluding Cattleya and Guarianthe.

*Flower size means as exhibited today.*

15. Cattleya and Guarianthe species.
16. Cattleya allied genera species other than above.
17. Cattleya and Guarianthe hybrids and intergenerics other than above, Lavender/Mauve, flowers 4 inches or less.
18. Cattleya and Guarianthe hybrids and intergenerics other than above, Lavender/Mauve, flowers larger than 4 inches.
19. Cattleya and Guarianthe hybrids and intergenerics other than above, White  
*no markings or other colors anywhere incl. lip*
20. Cattleya and Guarianthe hybrids and intergenerics other than above, Semi-Alba  
*no markings or colors anywhere except lip*
21. Cattleya and Guarianthe hybrids and intergenerics other than above, Yellow/Orange, flowers 4 inches or less.
22. Cattleya and Guarianthe hybrids and intergenerics other than above, Yellow/Orange, flowers larger than 4 inches.
23. Cattleya and Guarianthe hybrids and intergenerics other than above, Red/Red Shades, flowers 4 inches or less.
- 23a. Cattleya and Guarianthe hybrids and intergenerics other than above, Red/Red Shades, flowers larger than 4 inches.
24. Cattleya and Guarianthe hybrids and intergenerics other than above, Other Colors.
25. Cattleya allied genera hybrids and intergenerics other than above.

#### E. Cypripedium Alliance

27. Paphiopedilum species, normally one flower when mature.
28. Paphiopedilum species, normally two or more flowers when mature.
29. Paphiopedilum species, sequential blooming.

*Primary hybrid must have species as both parents.*

30. Paphiopedilum primary hybrids, White.
31. Paphiopedilum primary hybrids, Green/Yellow.
32. Paphiopedilum primary hybrids, Bronze/Mahogany.
33. Paphiopedilum primary hybrids, Red/Pink.
34. Paphiopedilum primary hybrids, Other Colors including Vinicolor.
- 34a. Paphiopedilum species and primary hybrids, Multifloral, any color, three or more flowers expected when mature.

*Complex hybrid has one or more non-species as parents.*

35. Paphiopedilum complex hybrids, White.
36. Paphiopedilum complex hybrids, Green/Yellow.
37. Paphiopedilum complex hybrids, Bronze/Mahogany.
38. Paphiopedilum complex hybrids, Red/Pink.
39. Paphiopedilum complex hybrids, Other colors including Vinicolors.
- 39a. Paphiopedilum complex hybrids, Multiflora, any color, three or more flowers when mature.

*TROPHY Classes 27-39a*

40. Phragmipedium species.
- 40a. Cypripedium, Selenepedium, Mexipedium species, hybrids and intergenerics.
41. Phragmipedium besseae and dalessandroi hybrids, excluding kovachii.  
*must include at least one of either besseae or dalessandroi in lineage.*
- 41a. Phragmipedium kovachii hybrids.
42. Phragmipedium hybrids, other than above.

## **F. Vanda and Phalaenopsis Alliance**

*Multiflora refers to flowers 3 inches or less, with multi-branched inflorescences when mature.*

44. Phalaenopsis hybrids, White, no markings or other color.
45. Phalaenopsis hybrids, White with colored lip, no markings.
46. Phalaenopsis hybrids, White, with markings.
47. Phalaenopsis hybrids, Multiflora, White, with or without markings. *Flowers less than 2"*
48. Phalaenopsis hybrids, Pink, no markings.
49. Phalaenopsis hybrids, Pink, with markings.
50. Phalaenopsis hybrids, Multiflora, Pink, with or without markings. *Flowers less than 2"*
51. Phalaenopsis hybrids, Yellow, no markings.
52. Phalaenopsis hybrids, Yellow, with markings.
53. Phalaenopsis hybrids, Multiflora, Yellow, with or without markings. *Flowers less than 2"*
54. Phalaenopsis hybrids, Other Colors, no markings.
55. Phalaenopsis hybrids, Other Colors, with markings.
56. Phalaenopsis hybrids, Multiflora, Other Colors, with or without markings. *Flowers less than 2"*
57. Phalaenopsis hybrids, Blushes. *Base color overlaid with singular red or pink color highlight and no markings*

*Vandaceous other than Phalaenopsis. Flower size means as exhibited today.*

58. Aerangis species, hybrids and intergenerics.
59. Angraecum species, hybrids and intergenerics, other than above.
60. Vanda species, flowers 1-1/2 inches or less.
- 60a. Vanda species, flowers larger than 1-1/2 inches.
61. Vanda hybrids, Orange/Yellow, flowers 1-1/2 inches or less.
- 61a. Vanda hybrids, Orange/Yellow, flowers larger than 1-1/2 inches.
62. Vanda hybrids, Red/Pink, flowers 1-1/2 inches or less.
- 62a. Vanda hybrids, Red/Pink, flowers larger than 1-1/2 inches.

70. Brassia species, hybrids and intergenerics.

75. Tolumnia (equitant Oncidium) species and hybrids.
76. Oncidium intergenerics other than above.
77. Traditional Odontoglossum species, hybrids, and intergenerics other than above.
78. Oncidium allied genera species, hybrids and intergenerics, other than above.

*Flower size means as exhibited today.*

79. Cymbidium hybrids, flowers 3 inches or larger.

82. Dendrobium species, Nobile type.

98. Orchid species not covered elsewhere.
99. Orchid hybrids and intergenerics not covered elsewhere.

*Miniature is defined as a diminutive plant in flower not exceeding 6 inches high and wide, excluding inflorescence.*

100. Miniature species, hybrids and intergenerics, Classes 27 – 42 and 58 – 99. (Excludes Cattleya and Phalaenopsis).

*First bloom seedling is defined as a blooming plant grown from seed with its first flower(s), cloned plants are excluded.*

101. Seedling flowering for the first time, Classes 10 through 100.
