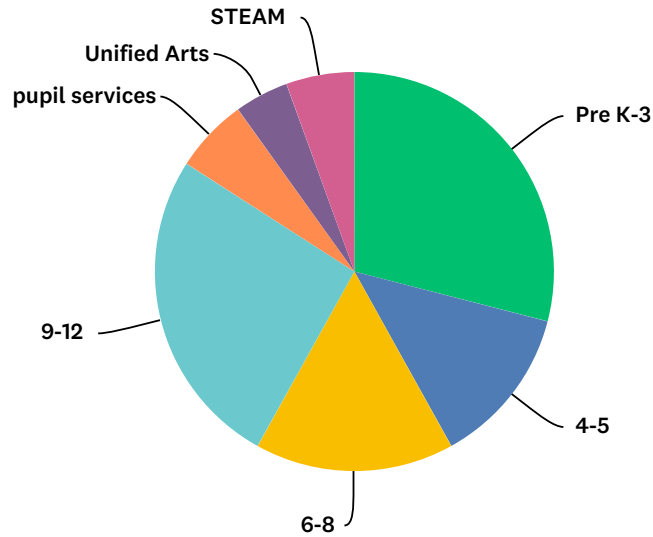


Q1 What is your current assignment?

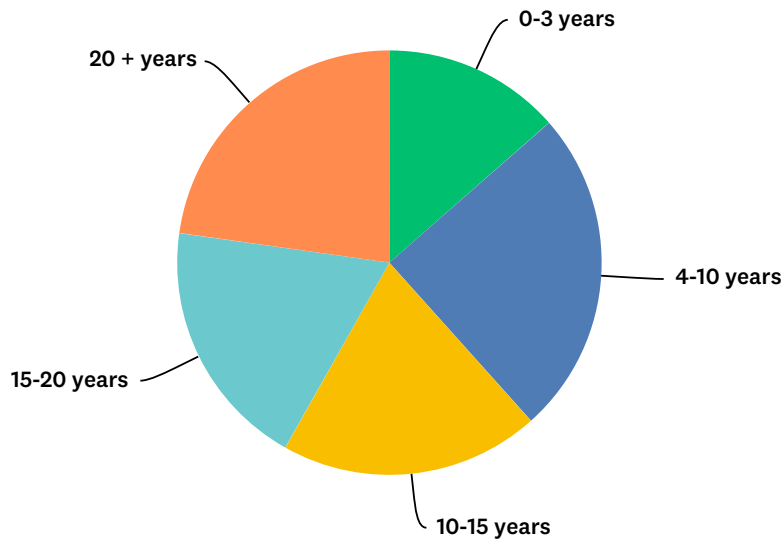

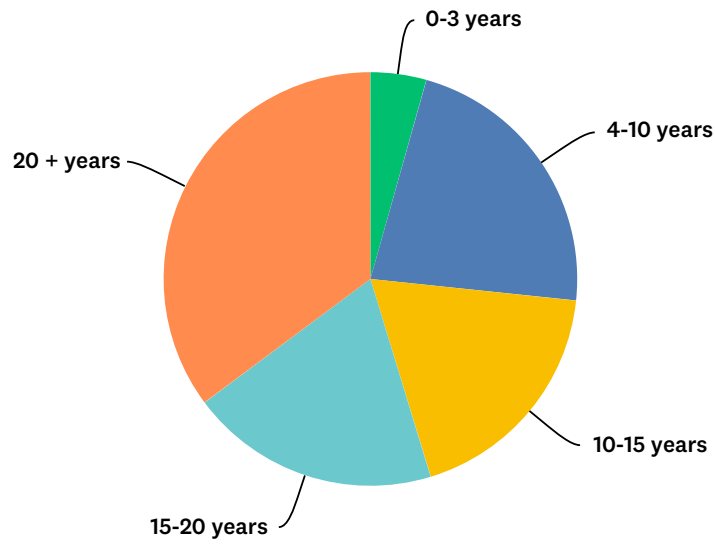

Q4 How many years have you taught in all?

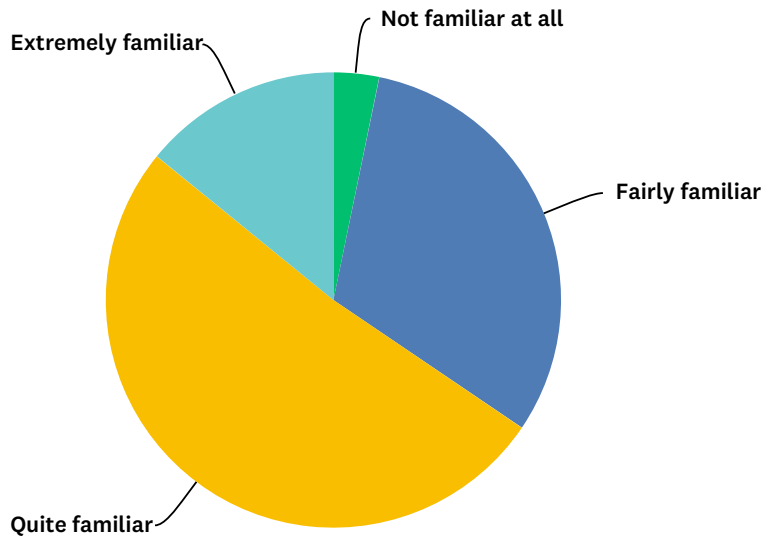

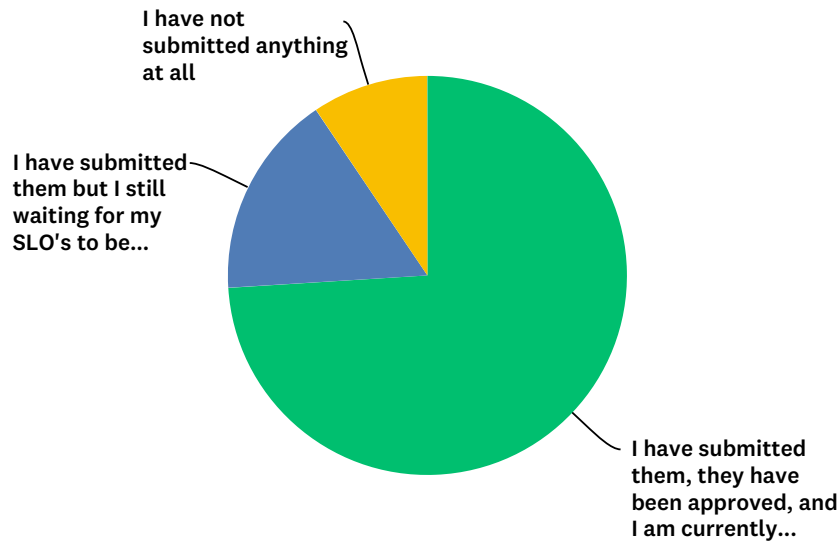

Q6 Where are you in the SLO process at this point?

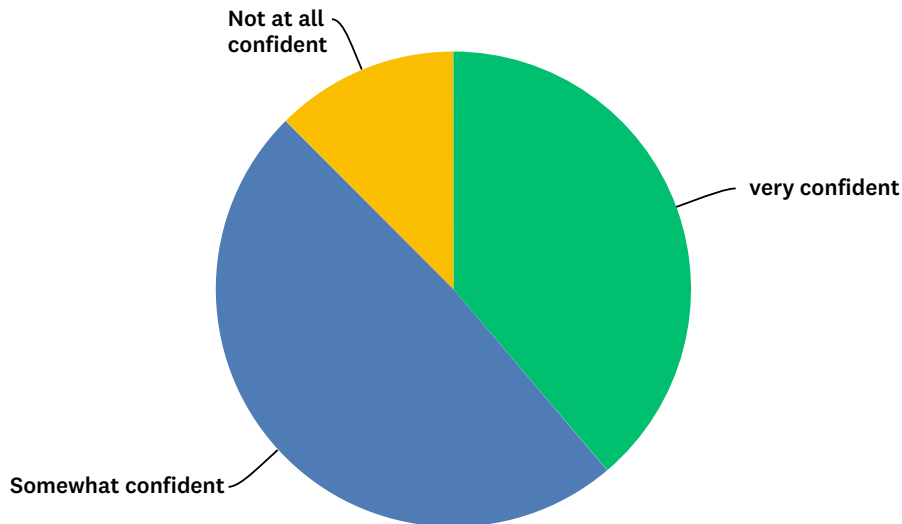

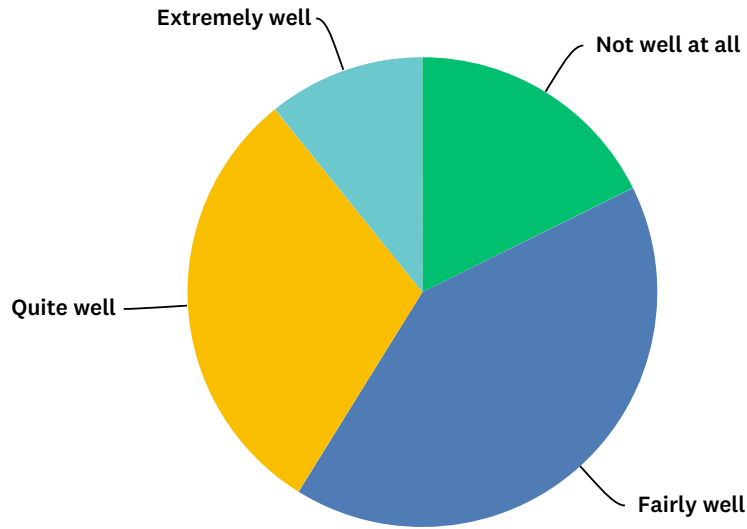

Q8 How well did administrators at your school/site support your SLO development, this year?

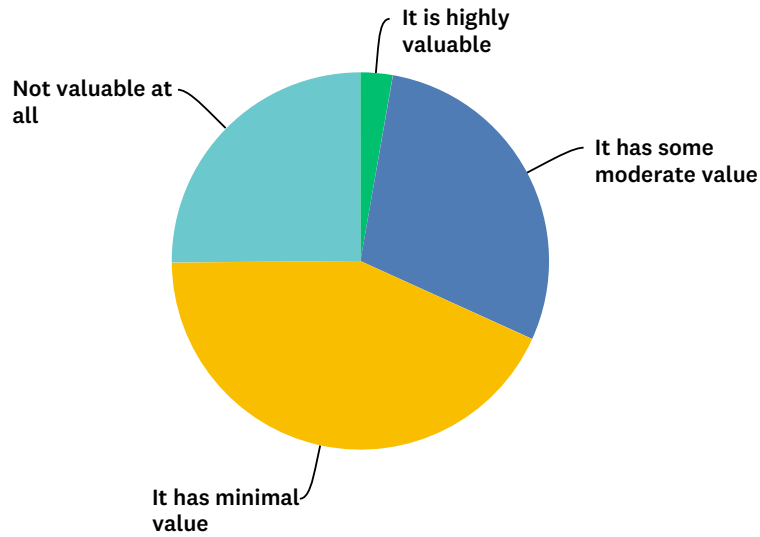

Q9 Overall, do you feel that the SLO process, as it exists, is of value to you and your teaching?

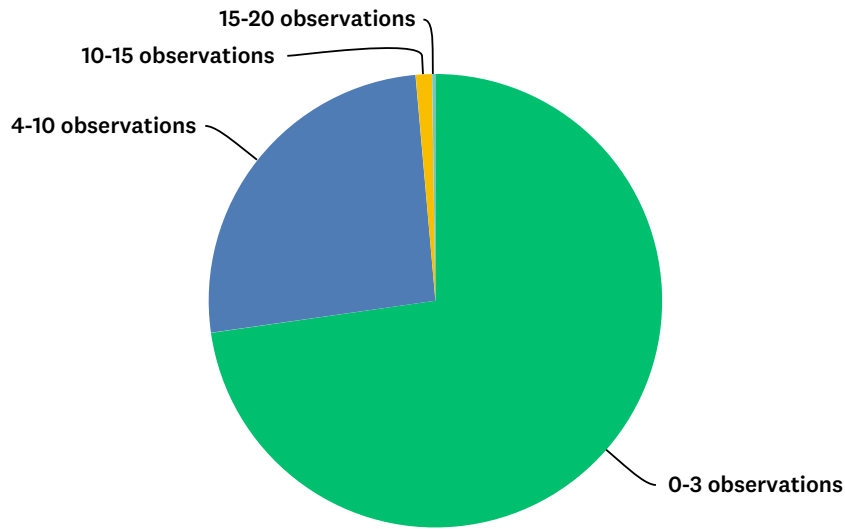

Q10 How many evaluator observations have you had at this point?

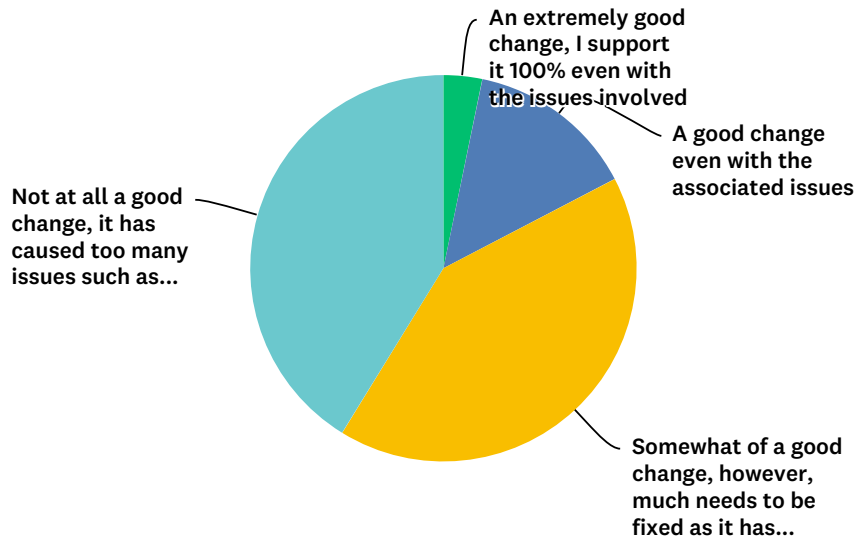

Q11 What is your current assessment on the redesign overall (trimester system, STEAM, Flex period at the high school, NBU) as experienced in your school?

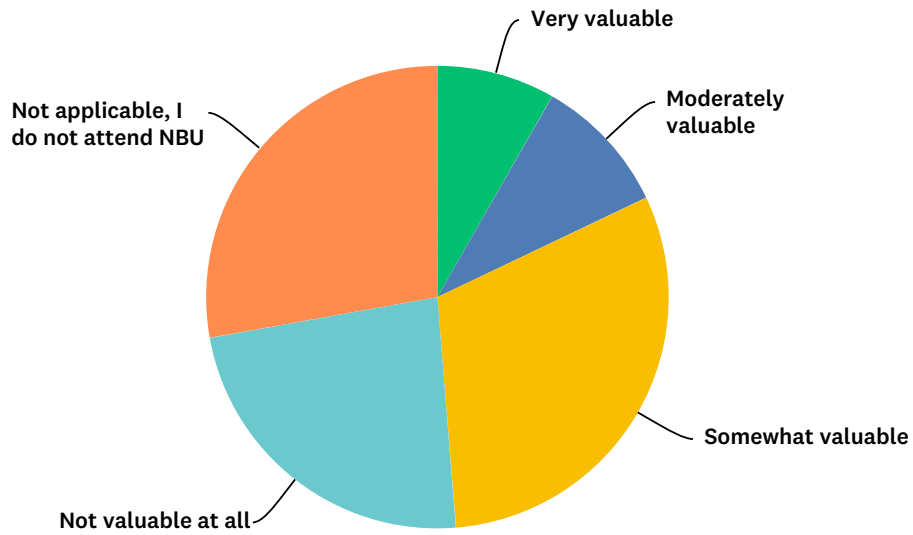

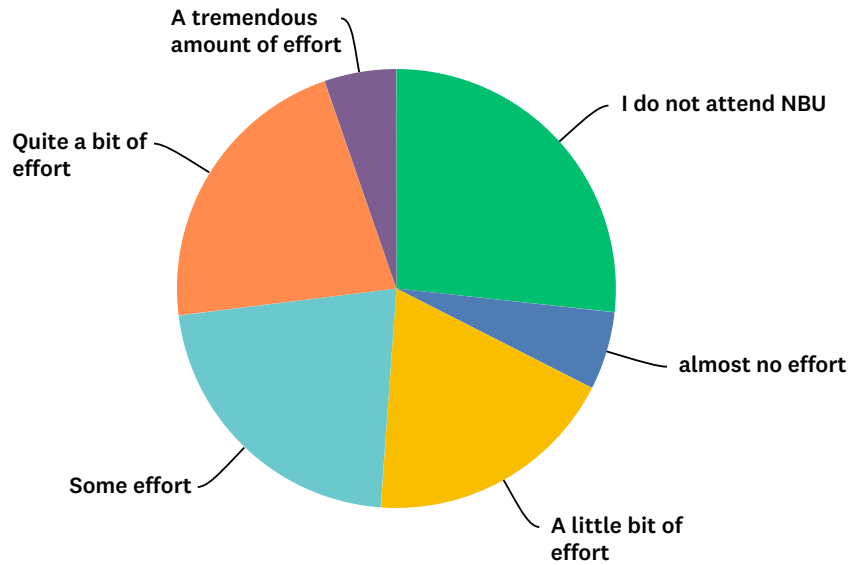

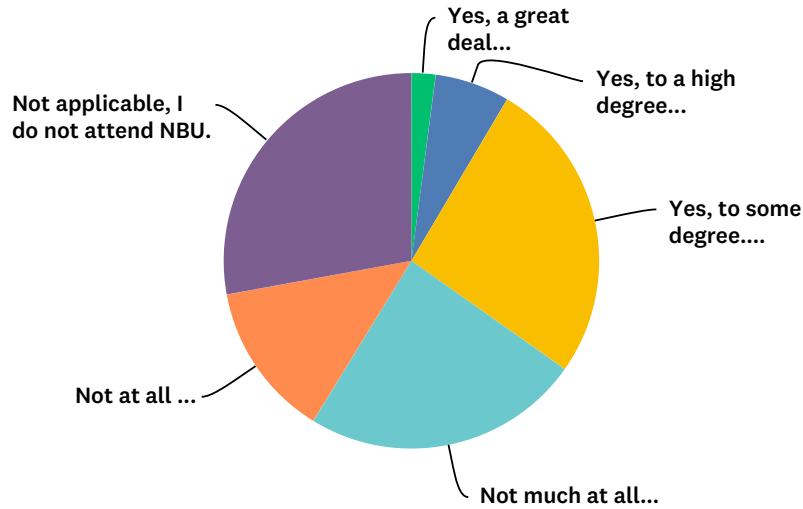

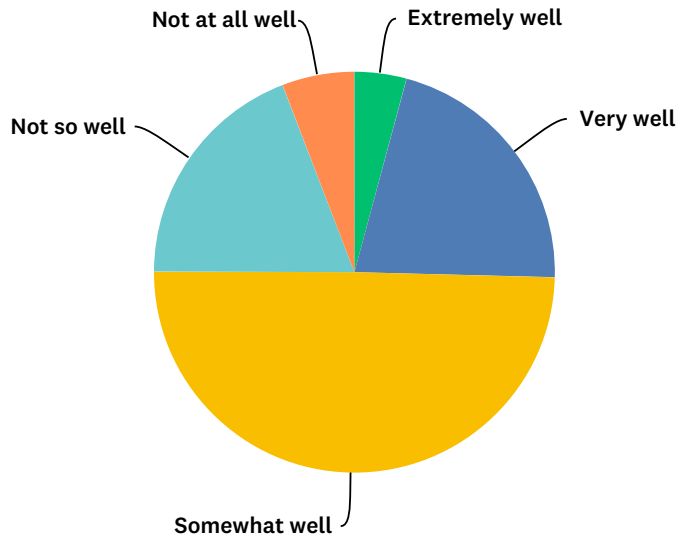

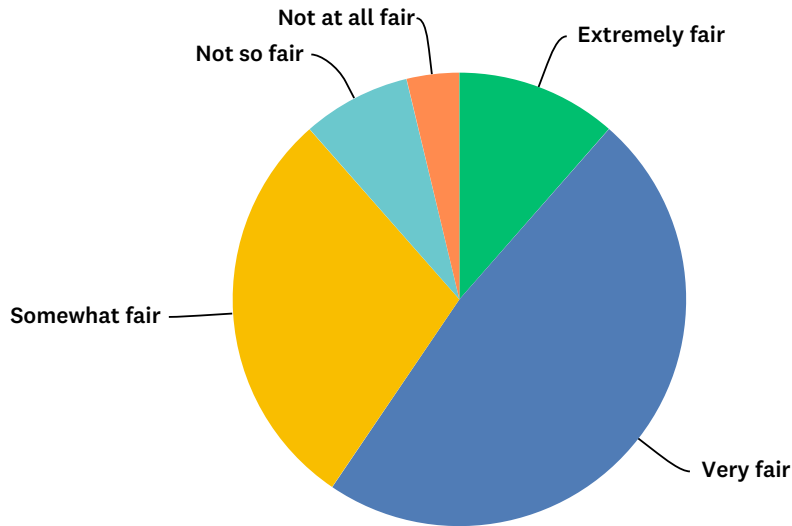

Q16 How fair do you feel your administrator's TEVAL ratings/scores have been with regards to your practice in the classroom/site?

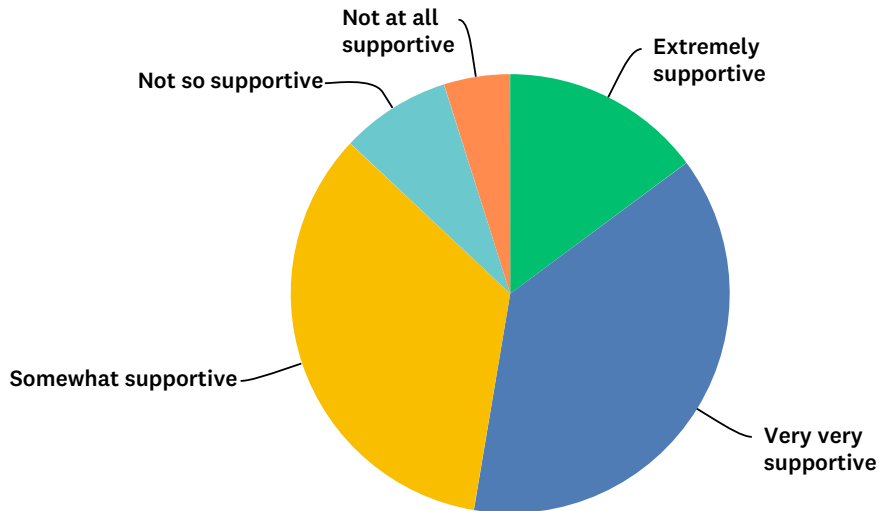

Q17 How supportive do you feel your administrator/evaluator has been with regards to the assessment of your practice in the classroom/site?

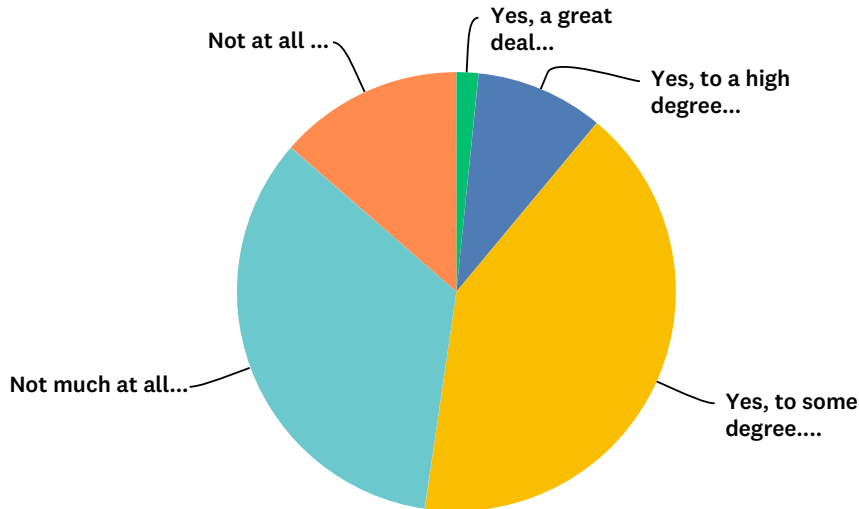

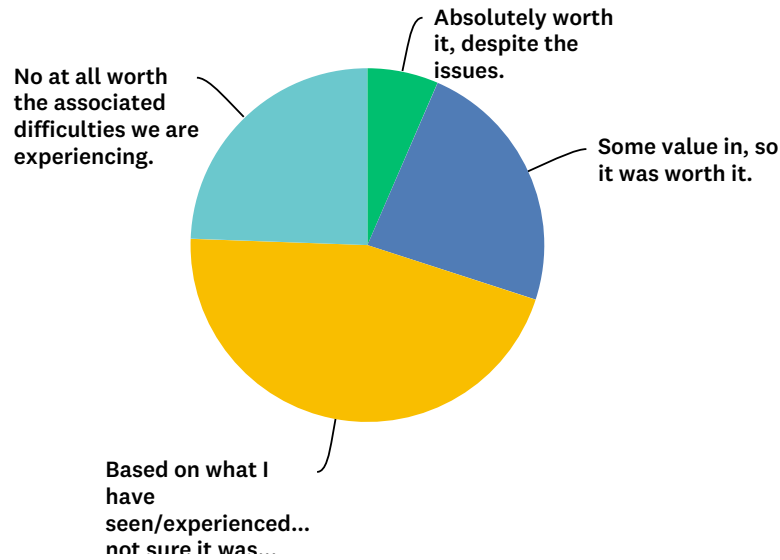
