Items From Board & Staff Dan Pyatt reported that the secondary irrigation system committee met and is having Terry investigate the cost of having a Valley wide secondary irrigation system study done. The committee is also going to work on an ordinance as on of the first steps. Terry reported he found a new sewer machine for \$37,000. Gary suggested Terry get a demo and factor it in to a future budget. Terry also reported that the Agency is going to participate in the upgraded GPS photo's of the valley with several other entities at a cost of roughly \$3000. Terry said interviews for the new maintenance position were conducted with an offer going to a local man who has certification and experience on the Agency's system. As it is not official yet, he declined to name the person, but he will start sometime in August.
