# ARRL RE: PAVE PAWS in California. (Via NARCC)

The 85th is the Air Force Engineering unit out of Keesler AFB that is responsible for all of the interference testing. They have recently finished some testing and it usually takes 4-6 weeks for them to share the results with ARRL and the FCC. It takes some time for the ARRL and FCC to work with the report once received.

Anyone who unilaterally decides they are going to just go back on line is making a potential major mistake. This is not a temporary interference problem. Anyone who goes back on line without mitigation risks a permanent shut down order from the FCC as well as potentially forcing the Air Force to request a mandatory quiet zone within 150-miles or so of the radar site of **ALL** amateur 70-cm activity. This is not a "passing problem". Amateur interference mitigation around the PPR sites is permanent.

This a small part of long response to NARCC by Dan Henderson, N1ND, ARRL Regulatory Information Manager . His e-mail contains a lot of information on why the problem has happened and what the Air Force does that they need Amateur Radio Operators to cooperate with repeater restrictions.

NEW ARES/RACES COORDINATOR FOR WEST


