Field Trips to the Museum

The Museum offers 4 Topic Specific guided tours designed to meet Florida educational standards: Paradise Gardens, Native Americans to Pioneers, Can You Dig It!?, and Technology Throughout History. Groups can also design their own custom tours! Each tour also features one of our hands-on activities: butter churning, pinch pots, pottery rubbings, chromatography butterflies, and more.

\$7 per student, \$3 for chaperones, teachers are free. Groups under 10 students are a flat rate of \$70.
