Directors Present: Dean Jessup, Patsy Gettings, Dan Gettings, and Rob Bannink, Brad Smith and Steve Sauser. George Cornell - Excused Absence

Members Present: We had 34 Members and guests attend in total. Great response !

Meeting called to order at 3:10 p.m. by President Dean Jessup. After introductions from all, and an opening prayer, the group enjoyed the Smoked Pull Pork lunch, along with all the great sides provided by each. Thanks to each for providing a great lunch!

1. The Meeting Minutes, from the July 20, 2019, were reviewed with no questions or revisions. Moved to approve by Brad S, supported by Steve S. Motion carried.
2. Treasurer's Report: Patsy Gettings handed out report and went over it in detail. PSA has a strong checkbook balance as we end our year. Steve S moved, supported by Rob B, to accept Treasurer's Report as presented – Motion carried.
3. Membership Update. Bruce reported that the current paid membership has jumped back to near 2018 levels.
4. Committee Reports: Clothing – Dan Gettings – We still have good inventory of most items for the remainder of this season. Dan will work on a new needs list for next year.

Thank you each for continuing your role as an officer.

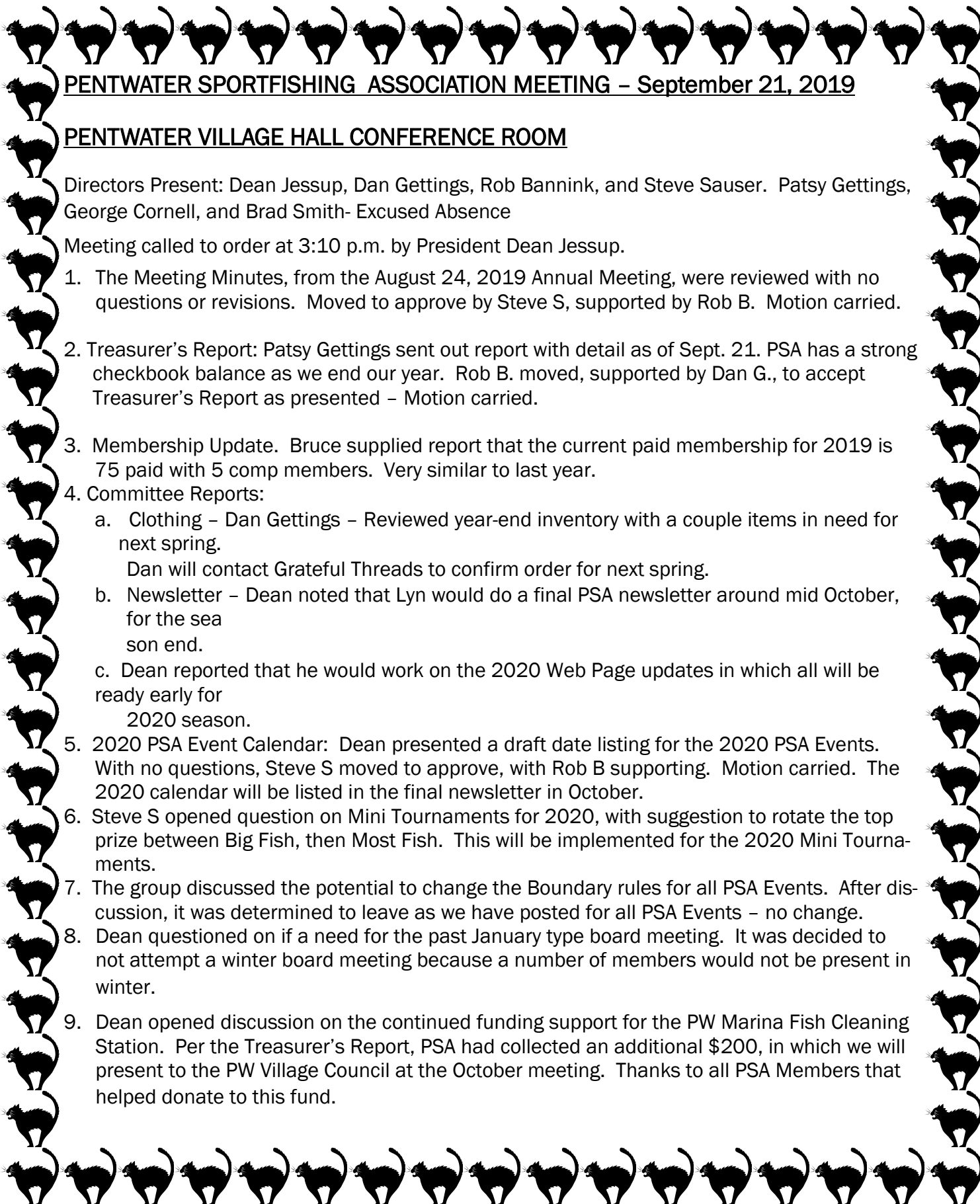

Directors Present: Dean Jessup, Dan Gettings, Rob Bannink, and Steve Sauser. Patsy Gettings, George Cornell, and Brad Smith- Excused Absence

Meeting called to order at 3:10 p.m. by President Dean Jessup.

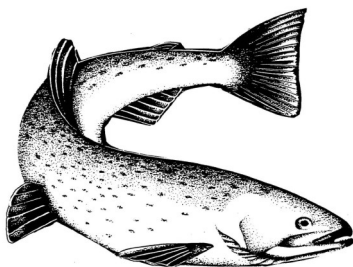
1. The Meeting Minutes, from the August 24, 2019 Annual Meeting, were reviewed with no questions or revisions. Moved to approve by Steve S, supported by Rob B. Motion carried.
2. Treasurer’s Report: Patsy Gettings sent out report with detail as of Sept. 21. PSA has a strong checkbook balance as we end our year. Rob B. moved, supported by Dan G., to accept Treasurer’s Report as presented – Motion carried.
3. Membership Update. Bruce supplied report that the current paid membership for 2019 is 75 paid with 5 comp members. Very similar to last year.
4. Committee Reports:
 - a. Clothing – Dan Gettings – Reviewed year-end inventory with a couple items in need for next spring.
Dan will contact Grateful Threads to confirm order for next spring.
 - b. Newsletter – Dean noted that Lyn would do a final PSA newsletter around mid October, for the season end.
 - c. Dean reported that he would work on the 2020 Web Page updates in which all will be ready early for 2020 season.
5. 2020 PSA Event Calendar: Dean presented a draft date listing for the 2020 PSA Events. With no questions, Steve S moved to approve, with Rob B supporting. Motion carried. The 2020 calendar will be listed in the final newsletter in October.
6. Steve S opened question on Mini Tournaments for 2020, with suggestion to rotate the top prize between Big Fish, then Most Fish. This will be implemented for the 2020 Mini Tournaments.
7. The group discussed the potential to change the Boundary rules for all PSA Events. After discussion, it was determined to leave as we have posted for all PSA Events – no change.
8. Dean questioned on if a need for the past January type board meeting. It was decided to not attempt a winter board meeting because a number of members would not be present in winter.
9. Dean opened discussion on the continued funding support for the PW Marina Fish Cleaning Station. Per the Treasurer’s Report, PSA had collected an additional \$200, in which we will present to the PW Village Council at the October meeting. Thanks to all PSA Members that helped donate to this fund.

Continued September PSA Meeting minutes.....

10. Discussion on the continued problem at the Village Launch Ramp, with the needed repair to the dock sections, that have exposed screws, which damage boats. Bruce Koorndyk has contacted the PW Village Manager and they are willing to supply the parts for repair and PSA will have a workday in the spring to fix. More info will follow to set a date next spring.
11. Dean presented the request from Marine Officer Tim Simon for support of the 2020 Water Safety Day. Dan G move, and Rob B supported, to have PSA again support this effort with a \$400 donation. Move carried.
12. Discussion on the 2020 Memorial Weekend Derby.
 - A. Dan G reported that Chris, Hillbilly Charters, would again offer the Charter Trip for our spring raffle. We set the 2020 spring raffle at: 1st Place, Charter Fishing Trip. 2nd Place, \$200 Cash. 3rd Place, \$100 Cash. Dean will work with Bruce to secure our raffle license earlier, and then have tickets printed and ready for distribution early spring 2020.
 - B. Dean noted that more help is needed to support all the parts of the Memorial Weekend Derby. Dean requested everyone decide to pick a part of needed work that they can commit to, so we have all parts covered. This then applies to all PSA Events also. We need added help to insure we can support all our events.

Meeting was adjourned at 4:15 p.m.
