Just a reminder:

Lillian Campbell Scholarship- Who was Lillian Campbell? Lillian was National President of the Ladies Auxiliary during its Golden Anniversary year 1963-64. "Opportunity for Friendship" was her special program. Lillian encouraged Auxiliaries to sponsor Memorial services for John F. Kennedy. Lillian joined the Auxiliary on the eligibility of her husband, William, a World War I Veteran. She was the first National President to be elected from Wisconsin. Lillian died at age 98 on May 26, 1996 at her home in Appleton, WI. Lillian's grandchildren live in Minnesota.

I am happy to announce that one of our recipients, (a veteran) from last year, graduated and is now a full-time nurse at Gundersen La Crosse Medical Center.
