

Beach Rules and Regulations:

The Gloria Glens Beach area is for the use and enjoyment of the MEMBERS of the Gloria Glens Association, their families and ACCOMPANIED guests ONLY.

~All residents in the Village of Gloria Glens are eligible to become a GGA member. Any person living in this village may NOT be a guest of current GGA member and a resident of the village.

~All members upon entrance to the beach will be asked their name and/or address and be requested to 'SIGN IN' by the Beach Attendant. This is part of the duties of the Beach Attendant to ensure our privacy here in the village.

~Guests using the beach MUST be escorted each visit by the GGA Member.

~NO children under the age of 9 years will be permitted in the beach area without adult supervision.

~There is NO LIFEGUARD on duty! SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK!

~NO swimming outside the designated swim area.

~NO DIVING OR JUMPING off the pier! The water is only about 1 foot deep.

~NO throwing of any type of objects-baseballs, footballs, Frisbees, or SAND! There is a basketball court inside the beach area and a volleyball court located by the parking lot for everyone's pleasure.

~NO boats/watercrafts are permitted in the swimming area. NO loading or unloading of passengers from the swimming area. NO fueling or parking your vessel within 300 ft of the swimming area for health and safety purposes!

~This a FAMILY LAKEFRONT-there is NO TOLERANCE for PROFANITY, ROWDINESS, or DISRESPECT to the Beach Attendant and/or MEMBERS using the lakefront facilities. IMMEDIATE DISMISSAL will result and membership of the contributing party may be in jeopardy.

~NO FISHING anywhere inside the fenced area.

~NO DOGS/CATS/PETS inside the beach or playground-use the DOGGIE POTS and CLEAN UP after YOUR pet! DO NOT leave your pet tied up anywhere along the fence. The VILLAGE OF GLORIA GLENS has a LEASH LAW ORDINANCE-you can be FINED!

~NO ALCOHOL or GLASS CONTAINERS or PICNICS

~There are ASH TRAYS available upon request. ASK the Beach Attendant for one.

~BE CONSIDERATE-The beach is for the enjoyment of the members and their families. Clean up after yourself and leave the area as you found it.

~NO BIKES/SCOOTERS by the Beach entrance. There is a BIKE RACK for your convenience at the end of the fence as you enter the island area. Please place all bikes at this location for everyone's safety.

~WATER FOUNTAIN- NO horseplay or NO washing of sand toys at the fountain.

Please take a minute to review the rules with your family members using the facilities. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact an Officer or Trustee. THANK YOU!

Parking Permits:

2016 Parking Permits will be issued after the dues have been paid. Each permit is \$5. There is no limit on how many stickers may be purchased. These permits are a face adhesive 'sticker' that can be removed with no residue and are REQUIRED to park in the parking lot on the lakefront.

PLACEMENT-the 'sticker' needs to be placed in the FRONT LOWER LEFT OR RIGHT CORNER of the WINDSHIELD on EVERY vehicle. This is so our Beach Attendant and Sheriff's Department can locate them easily and TICKET anyone who is not registered.

NO overnight parking at the LAKEFRONT.

NO boat trailers are to be parked in this area for any length of time-parking space is limited to VEHICLES ONLY!

Requirements for BOAT ACCESS to the LAKE:

1. Paid up membership to the GGA of current year
2. Complete Application
3. Proof of dwelling ownership of the Village of Gloria Glens-NO RENTERS
4. Title of each watercraft(must be in the PROPERTY OWNERS NAME)
5. Insurance policy
6. Driver's license
7. Current Boat Ramp Key Number
8. Boat Dock Location-if a private dock/location-please supply diagram

Boat Ramp History:

The Gloria Glens Association has been responsible for the activity at the Boat Ramp for over 50 years. It was the responsibility of the three trustees to open and close the gate when a member wanted to put a boat on the lake. The member had to contact a trustee to make arrangements to meet at the boat ramp to get their boat on the lake. Then it was decided to move into the convenience era. The Officers and Trustees decided the members were responsible enough to pass out keys for the boat ramp. Once proof of property ownership, watercraft title, registration, insurance policy and I.D. were obtained, the member was issued a key and sticker for each watercraft. Every couple of years the lock is changed and new keys are issued for a small replacement fee. As of 2009, there is a Key Replacement Policy. If you lose your key there is a ONE TIME REPLACEMENT KEY of \$100. If it happens a second time, you forfeit your privilege and will have to contact a Trustee to open the gate at THEIR convenience. Along with this policy, the key you are assigned is YOUR key and not to be given to another person for use. If this should occur, the GGA will repossess the key.
