**Burn Permits are now Required :** As spring arrives we remind folks that outdoor burning of brush requires that a burn permit must first be acquired. They are available as follows:

Weekday from 8-4:30 PM at the Police Department  
Weekends from 9-noon at the Central Fire Station

**Monthly Financial Report:** At the close of March we were 75% into the fiscal year. Revenues at that point came in just under 72% while expenditures were just under 71%. We continue to review the state revenue picture as well as the proposed impacts of the Governor's proposal. If we need we will postpone some spring projects to assure that the Town finishes the year in the black.

**Reminder of property taxes Due:** As the last quarterly payment of property taxes approaches we want to remind our tax payers accordingly. May 15, 2013 at 4:00 PM is the deadline after which interest would be an additional charge. We encourage all property tax payers to make their payments prior to the deadline to avoid any delinquent charges.

**Saturday Office Hours:** We remind our citizens that we will hold office hours on the last Saturday in April, May and June from 8-11:30 AM. During this time the only transactions to be conducted with be vehicle and boat registrations as well as the collection of any property tax payments.
