MESSAGE FROM BISHOP DANIELS RE: CHURCH RE-OPENING

Dear Friends,

At a news briefing this afternoon (February 9th), Dr. Fitzgerald announced that: **effective Saturday, February 12 at 00:01 am**, we will be allowed up to 50% capacity, with social distancing, to attend celebrations of Mass. All other current restrictions remain in place. These are:

- Masks must be worn at all time.
- Physical distancing is mandatory.
- No congregational singing
- Cantors only.
- A list of all attendees with contact information must be kept to 14 days.
- Those at higher risk of complications due to CoVid-19 should not attend parish celebration.
- Baptisms, Weddings and Funerals remain under their current restrictions:
- Limited to no more than 50 people or 25 per cent capacity (whichever is less). Physical distancing must be maintained.
- Public visitations are permitted, with one household bubble visiting at a time.
- Wakes are prohibited.

She announced further that: **effective Monday February 14 at 00:01 am**, Baptisms, Weddings and Funerals we will be allowed up to 50% capacity with social distancing and all other restrictions as above.

February 17 - Memorial of the Seven Holy Founders of the Servite Order:

Between 1225 and 1227, seven men from the city of Florence, Italy, joined the Confraternity of the Blessed Virgin. Inspired by visions of Our Lady, they decided to dedicate themselves to lives of prayer and service. Later they withdrew to a deserted mountain where they built a Church and hermitage, living a life of extreme austerity, and becoming known as the Servants of Mary, or Servites. Of the original seven, all but one became Priests. Only the lay brother, who lived to be 110, saw the order fully recognized in 1304.
